ANDREWS CUP ASSOCIATION - BASKETBALL COMPETITION

The Andrews Cup Basketball competition will be held at **The Coomera Indoor Sports Centre, 35 Beattie Road, Coomera, on Thursday 3 November 2022.** Competition will commence at 9:00am and conclude at 2:45pm, followed by Presentations.

TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS:

Transport to and from Coomera will be by chartered bus, with the students Coach, Mr Brodie Meis, accompanying them. Students are to assemble at the Tuckshop area promptly at **6:45am** to have their name marked off the roll before departure.

At the conclusion of the competition, students may travel home with their parents/caregivers from the venue but must check out with a Clayfield College teacher before leaving. All students are required to stay for the presentation. The bus will then return to Clayfield College, Bayview Terrace, at approximately **4:30pm** where students should be collected promptly.
