Ivanhoe Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of student learning items and activities to a minimum to make them affordable for all families. School Council recognise that every family has been impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 and therefore <u>no increases to family charges will be applied for 2021</u>. In an effort to provide further support to families, several payment options are also available.
