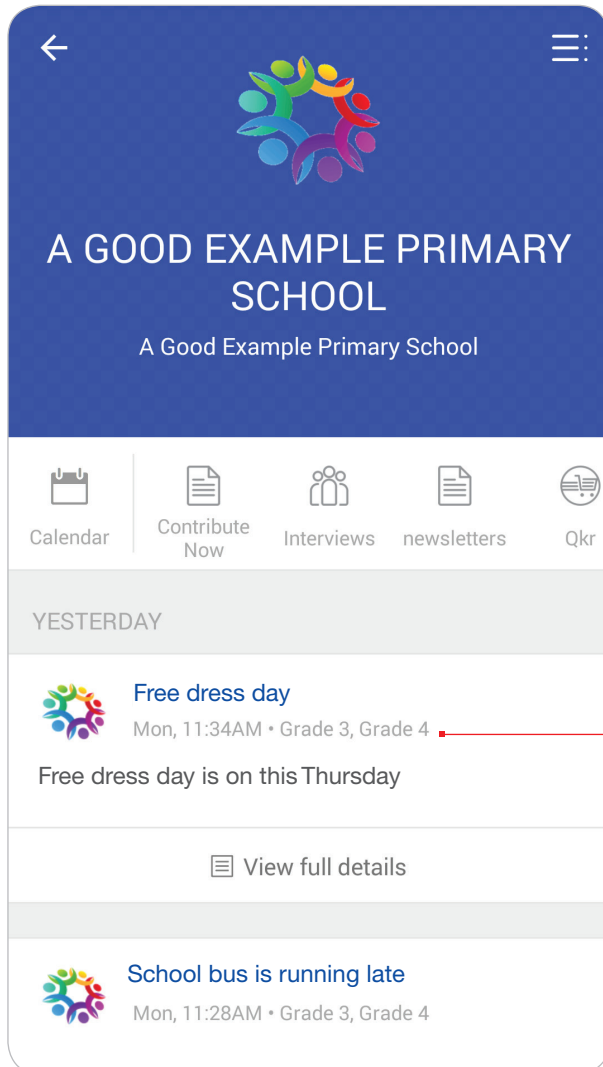

Note for people connected to a school:

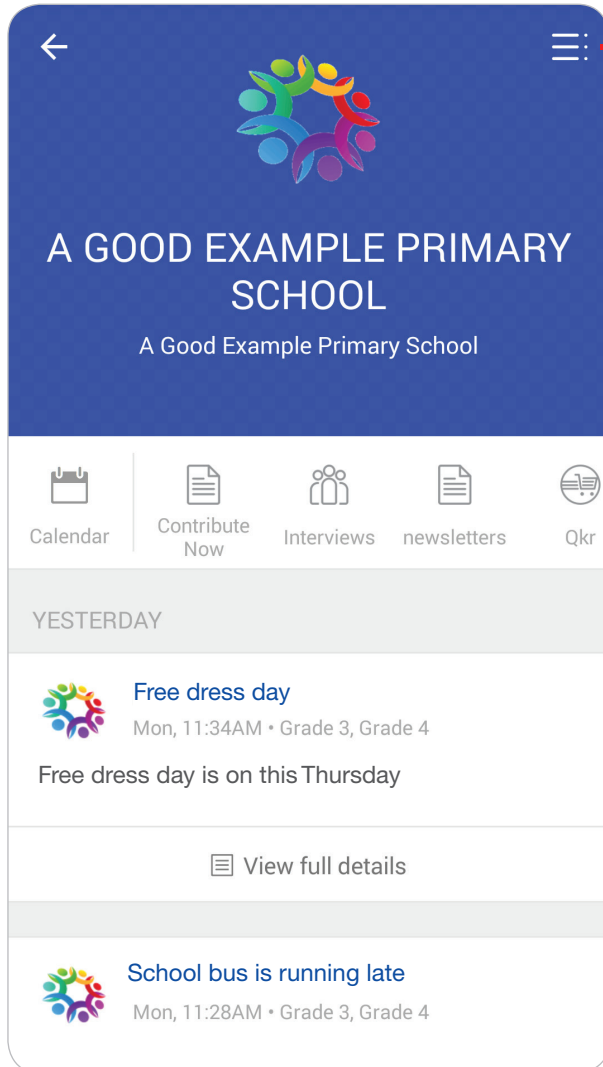
The new tiqbiz does not require the 'Whole School' box and in most cases has been removed from schools accounts.

Simply select the boxes that apply to you and you will receive all the relevant information from your school.

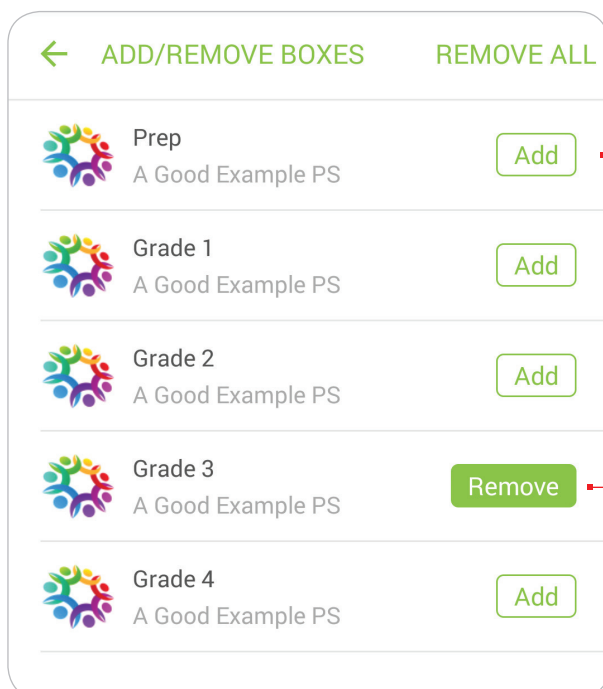
Changing your box selections

Changing your selection is done by simply clicking 'Add' or 'Remove'

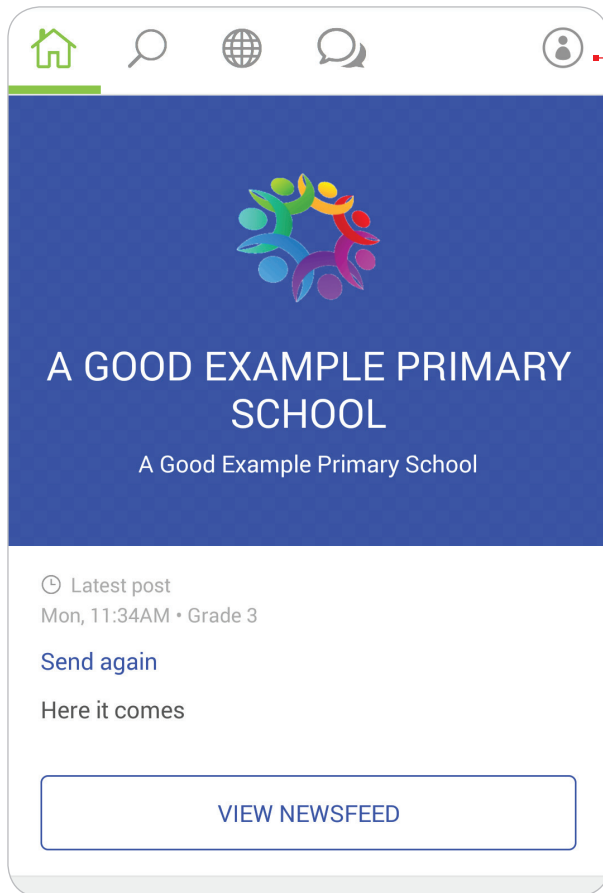


Click menu icon to open box options
