Dear Parents and Music Students,

The Junior School Music Night is the second of three major Trinity music concerts to be held in Term 2 on, **Friday 12 June 2026**.

**THE CONCERT WILL COMMENCE AT 6:30pm.**

**Performers will need to be at school no later than 6:00pm** – Any students who arrive before 6pm will need to remain with parents in Carrigg Court.

The concert will feature the following ensembles; Year 5/6 String Ensemble, Junior Chamber String Ensemble, Junior Concert Band, Year 4 Choir, Year 5/6 Choir and the Junior Vocal Ensemble.
