Is your child learning to read?

The Library has a great collection of Readers to get your child started on their reading journey.

We've introduced a new system to help you choose the right book at the right time for your child.

Group 1 Read: designed for beginner readers these books have 1-2 sentences per page and will help to build confidence and comprehension.

Group 2 Green: designed for those progressing readers these books have 3-6 sentences per page and use simple language to continue to build reading skills.

Group 3 Blue: these books have longer sentences and paragraphs with multi-syllable words and will help to develop more advanced reading skills.

Group 4 Yellow: these short chapter books with 4-10 chapters are the final stage before launching into regular children's novels.
