The Austdrive Youth Driver Awareness Program is designed for 16- 21year olds across SA, and goes beyond the scope of any learner training previously done, the Austdrive program training meets each young driver at their level and is designed to give young drivers a realistic view of their actual abilities (as opposed to what they think they can do). The course focuses on practical driver awareness, resulting in a true perspective; not the one their peers have given them. Prevention is better than cure when lives are at risk.

Course content includes:

- Basic car dynamics and control skills
- Emergency braking
- When two wheels are off the bitumen
- Safe steering
- Wildlife dangers
- Understanding speed, fatigue, alcohol, peer pressure
- Safe following distances
- Car modification (what's real and what's not)
- Observation techniques
- Emergency collision avoidance

The Austdrive 2 Youth Driver Awareness Program is designed for younger, less experienced drivers across Australia, 18-25 yr olds, who currently hold a probationary licence or a full licence. All 'in vehicle' training with 1 instructor. You can book for 1, 2 or 3 young drivers to undertake this training together.

Learning Outcomes:

- Understand the importance of safe driving and decision making
- Understand and identify the hazards and risks associated with driving in a range of conditions
- The ability to apply safe driving methods and demonstrate preventative strategies in accordance with World's Best Practice and Australian Road Law

Course content includes:

- Vehicle Checks, Seating, steering, and mirror set up
 - Attitude and driver readiness
 - Braking and principles, early, linear, threshold and split surface
 - Line and cornering principles, approach, entry, apex, and exit
 - Travelling distances, safety buffers, driving to conditions, speed limits low ground clearance, high centre of gravity
 - Rural Driving and Wildlife, Adverse conditions
