- 4) Entries must be flat (no sculpture or collage), landscape orientation, and either submitted on A4 paper without creases, or as a digital pdf file.
- 5) Complete the entry form on this pamphlet and attach to the back of the artwork or with the digital file. Return these to your child's teacher, who will submit these to Jacqui Norrie, Cleanaway, P.O Box 159, Moree 2400. jacqui.norrie@cleanaway.com.au.
- Entries may be submitted individually, or as a class or school effort.
 Only one entry per individual, class or school effort will be accepted.
- Each entry will be individually judged by Cleanaway and Moree Plains Shire Council employees. Entries will be judged based on artistic merit and how well they depict the competition theme.
- 8) The judges' decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into.
- 9) Parents/ guardians and schools of the winner and finalist will be notified by 18/09/2020.
- 10) The winner will be awarded a \$150 local gift card.
- 11) All entries will remain the property of Cleanaway and Moree Plains Shire Council.
- 12) Entrants' names and their photographs may be used by Cleanaway and/or Moree Plains Shire Council for promotional purposes.
- 13) Cleanaway and Moree Plains Shire Council reserve the right to slightly alter the winning artwork for promotional use.
- 14) Cleanaway and Moree Plains Shire Council will not be held liable for loss or damage to the entries.
- 15) Entries received may not be returned.

The Art Competition

We're calling all students to create an A4 landscape picture that celebrates our 'Be green, keep your recycling clean' theme.

Artwork can be on paper or digital. The use of bold colours using paint and/or text is encouraged. Entries may be submitted individually, or as a class or school effort. Kindergarten to year 12 students who attend a school in the Moree Plains Shire area can enter.

The picture should show the importance of recycling properly. Students should consider what goes in the recycling 'yellow lid' bin and how simple it can be to remember to always recycle correctly. They should also think about the environmental benefits of recycling and why we should always recycle.

Paper, cardboard, glass, plastic and tins from our kitchens, laundries and bathrooms are the ONLY five items that should be placed in the recycling 'yellow lid' bins!

Always keep your recyclables empty, clean, dry and unbagged to avoid contamination.

Contamination occurs when we place the wrong things in our recycling bins. Items that should never go in your recycling bin are: plastic bags, clothing, green waste, food and liquids.

The winner will have their artwork printed onto the side of a Cleanaway waste collection truck and receive a \$150 EFT card. The runner-up will also receive a \$50 EFT card.
