

## **2022 WOODWIND / BRASS SHARED LESSONS**

NECOM provides outstanding instrumental tuition, solo and ensemble performance training to children through to adults at the NECOM Campus or in schools.

New England Conservatorium of Music (NECOM) is pleased to offer small group Woodwind/ Brass lessons with the conservatorium's highly qualified music educators, Mr Paul Marshall, Mr James McKay and Mr Bruce Myers.

These small group lessons will be held at your child's school in partnership with the school commencing in term 2 and continuing through term 3.

As an introductory offer, NECOM is offering 8 x 30-minute lessons for \$200 per term i.e. \$400 for both terms 2 and 3 which includes instrument hire which is usually \$100 per term.

If you would like to enrol your child, please fill in NECOM's online enrolment from at <a href="https://necom.org.au/new-student/">https://necom.org.au/new-student/</a> prior to 7 April to secure the spot.

Students will have the opportunity to choose from one of the following instruments: Clarinet, Flute, French Horn, Saxophone, Trombone, Trumpet or Tuba. NECOM's teacher will assist your child in this process.

Once you have enrolled online, NECOM will invoice you for one term at a time. NECOM will provide free instrument hire as an introductory offer however, a bond of \$220 will be required prior to collecting the hire instrument. To help with payment NECOM does accept Service NSW's "Creative Kids Vouchers".

These groups are provided to give new students a chance to try out the instruments and lessons before committing to further tuition. There are many opportunities in Armidale for young musicians, inside school and out, and new players are always in demand! We only have a limited number of instruments so make sure you get in early to avoid missing out!
