





HOW DO I SEARCH THE CATALOGUE?






HOW DO I ACCESS TV SHOWS, MOVIES AND DOCUMENTARIES?

- 2.Click on the **TV4Education** button at the top of the SmartSuite homepage.


In both ClickView and TV4Education you can browse or search the list of available movies and TV shows to stream.

HOW DO I BORROW A BOOK?

Bring the book you want to borrow to the library desk together with your compass card and we will check it out to you.

All book loans are for a **2 week period** after which you will need to return the book or renew it at the desk.

HOW MANY BOOKS CAN I BORROW AT ONCE?

You can borrow **5** books at any one time.

We don't have overdue fines, but long overdue books must be returned or you will be charged a replacement fee.


No problem! We have a whole school subscription to The Age Digital Replica.
