I am moving to a different location today. I am hoping to have a bit of a wander and I will update if I find somewhere.


Day 6

The nights are very cold in this environment, often dropping to near freezing temperatures. Thankfully my sleeping bag is very warm and my tent shelters me from the cold winds.

Day 8

Today I focused on getting supplies such as fire wood, after the recent chilly nights. I recently weaved a small basket out of some fiber that I found so hopfully I can find some berrys to put in there.



I am going to set up some more traps today. I have used up all of my food now.



The temperature at night continues to be cold whilst the days are still very hot. I feel I am dehydrated a lot, and continue to return to the nearby pond for water. Without that pond, I surely would not have made it this far.

Day 10

I successfully caught a kangaroo rat. I think I caught it around 2 am. It woke me up but thats okay. I heard it rustling around in my tent and awoke to find it inside.



Today my already sore snake bite got infected. Im going to take it easy. I found some aloe vera to put on the wound. It seems to continually burn and sting.

Day 13

Day 27


