### **VAS COMPETITION RECIPE**

### **VAS SENIOR RICH FRUIT CAKE**

250 g Sultanas

250 g Chopped raisins

250g Currents

125 g Mixed Peel

90 g chopped red glace cherries

90 g chopped blanched almonds

1/3 cup brandy or sherry

250 g Plain Flour

14 teaspoon grated nutmeg

½ teaspoon ground ginger

Mix t¼ teaspoon ground cloves

250 g butter

250 g soft brown sugar

½ teaspoon lemon essence OR finely grated lemon rind

½ teaspoon almond essence

½ teaspoon vanilla essence

4 Large eggs

Mix together all fruits and nuts and sprinkle with brandy or sherry. Cover and leave for one hour but preferably overnight.

Sift flour and spices

Cream together the butter and sugar with the essences. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well. Alternately add the fruit and flour mixtures. Place mixture into a greased and lined 20 cm square tin.

Bake in a slow oven for approximately 3 ½ - 4 hours or until cooked.

Allow to cool in the tin.

#### **VAS SENIOR CARROT CAKE**

375 g Plain Flour

2 teaspoon Baking Powder

1 1/2 teaspoons Bicarbonate of Soda

2 teaspoons Ground Cinnamon

½ teaspoon Ground Nutmeg

½ teaspoon all spice

Pinch Salt

345 g Caster Sugar

375 ml Vegetable Oil

4 Eggs

3 Medium Grated Carrots (350 g)

220 g tin of Crushed Pineapple, drained

180g Chopped Pecan Nuts

Preheat oven to 180 deg celcius. Grease and line a 23 cm Round tin

Sift Dry ingredient into bowl. Use a separate bowl, beat the eggs, and oil.

Add this to the dry ingredients, mix well, then add carrots, pineapple and nuts.

Pour into cake tin and bake for 90 - 100 minutes or until cooked.

#### **VAS JUNIOR CARROT AND SULTANA MUFFIN**

Recipe 2 1/2 cups SR Flour

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

14 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1 cup brown sugar

1/3 cup chopped in ½ Sultanas

1 cup coarsely grated carrot

1 tablespoon orange marmalade

1 cup canola oil

2 eggs lightly beaten

% cup orange juice

1 cup reduced fat milk

Pre heat oven to 190 Degree C [Moderate hot] Line a 12 hole muffin pan with white Muffin cases 35 mm High X 90 mm Wide X 50 mm Base Stir dry ingredients in a large bowl, then add carrots and sultanas.

Combine marmalade, oil, eggs juice and milk Mix into dry ingredients, until just combined Spoon mixture evenly into muffin cases Cook for 20 minutes or until cooked Stand muffins in pan for five minutes before removing to cool.

#### **VAS JUNIOR BOILED FRUIT CAKE**

Entrant must follow provided recipe

Recipe 375 g mixed fruit

¾ cup of brown sugar

1 teaspoon mixed spice

1/2 cup water

125 g butter

½ teaspoon bicarbonate of soda

½ cup sherry

2 eggs, slightly beaten

2 tablespoons marmalade

1 cup SR Flour

1 cup Plan Flour

1/4 teaspoon salt

Method Place mixed fruit, sugar, water, spice and butter in large saucepan and bring to boil. Simmer gently for 3 minutes, then remove from stove and add bicarbonate of soda. Allow to cool Add Sherry, eggs and marmalade, mixing well. Fold in sifted dry ingredients then place in a greased and lined 20 cm round cake tin. BAKE in a moderate slow oven for 1 ½ hours or until cooked.

Allow to cool for 10 minutes in the tin, then onto wire rack to cool

### **NDAS ANZAC BISCUITS SENIOR & JUNIOR**

Recipe 1 cup one-minute oats

1 cup SR Flour

1 cup sugar

1 cup desiccated coconut

1 tablespoon Golden Syrup

125 g Butter

2 Tablespoons water

1 teaspoon Bicarbonate soda Mix ALL Dry ingredients in a bowl.

Melt together butter, golden syrup and water. Add in Bicarbonate of soda, stir until mixture foams. Add this to dry ingredients and mix well.

Place rolled teaspoons of the mixture onto a tray, leaving room to spread. Bake in Moderate oven until brown. Cool on tray.

### **NDAS JUNIOR CHOCOLATE CAKE**

Recipe 1 cup Self Raising Flour

2 eggs

½ cup milk

125 g melted butter

1 cup caster sugar

1 tsp vanilla

3 tbl cocoa

Pinch Salt

Line and grease 20 cm tin round cake tin. Preheat oven to 180 degreees.

Whisk eggs slightly, add milk and vanilla and set aside. Sift SR Flour, salt and cocoa together, add caster sugar, mixing together. Add egg mixture and melted butter with the whisk. Mix well. Pour mixture into prepared tin. Place in pre-heated oven for 35 minutes or until cooked with skewer. Remove from oven and cool for 5 minutes. Turn out onto tea towel covered cooling tray to cool.
