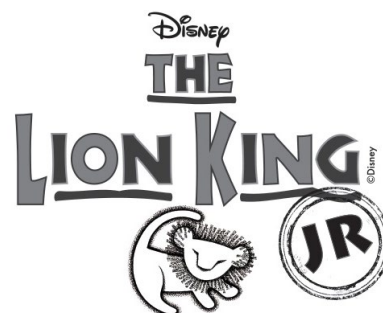


Disney's THE LION KING JR.

Shelford Girls' Grammar – Junior School

Disney's *The Lion King JR.* is playing at Shelford Girls' Grammar on Wednesday 22 and Thursday 23 June at 7pm. The 60-minute musical, is based on the Broadway production directed by Julie Taymor and the 1994 Disney film.

Tickets for ***The Lion King JR.*** will open to the Junior School on **Monday 6 June at 9am** via a link on Shelly. Admission is \$20 (adults) and \$10 (child).



This letter provides information for the Production Week. There will be an increase of rehearsals and performances in Weeks 8 and 9, please be mindful of your daughter's tiredness as she prepares for these weeks. There will be a lot of excitement in the air.

Timeline of rehearsals/performances

Week 8 – Rehearsals

- Monday:** QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY/NO REHEARSAL
- Tuesday:** After lunch rehearsal/walk through
- Wednesday:** After lunch rehearsal/walk through
LEADS: After school rehearsal (fitted for mic) until 4.30pm
- Thursday:** NO REHEARSAL
- Friday:** After lunch rehearsal/dress rehearsal

Week 9 – Production Week

- Monday:** Dress rehearsal 8.30-10.15am
- Tuesday:** Dress rehearsal/Makeup 10.15am
- Wednesday:** Matinee (practice run-through) 10am
Evening Performance at 7pm
- Thursday:** Evening Performance at 7pm



Costumes

Year 3-6 students in the Junior School will be provided a costume for their character in *The Lion King Jr.* Students are to bring in a labelled bag on **30 May**. This bag will be used to store their costume. Because there will be some costume changes for students, it is recommended that girls wear a singlet and bike shorts underneath their costume in Years 3-6.

JDC students will be provided a costume for their character in *The Lion King Jr.* Students in JDC are required to bring a black t-shirt and black bike shorts in a labelled bag by the **27 May**. No logos or prints on black t-shirt please.



Masks

Please be aware and consider that with movement, lighting, costuming and the pace of the show, masks may contribute to overheating and increase discomfort when performing.

Makeup

Stage makeup is essential when performing on stage. A base level of foundation, small eye makeup and colored lips is expected from students in the ensemble (JDC to Year 6). Please bring makeup in a small labelled bag on the night of the performance. Please find an example below:



Lead students will have their makeup applied by staff members. They are required to bring in their own foundation in a small labelled bag.

Supervision and Designated Holding Rooms

BEFORE THE SHOW- drop off

Lead Characters:

- Please arrive at 5.30pm in the Hall for makeup and mic testing
- Wear comfortable clothing. Costumes will be made available in your holding area

JDC to Year 6 Ensemble:

- Please arrive at 6pm in your **designated holding areas**, with base makeup on
- JDC please arrive in your black t-shirt and bike shorts
- Year 3-6, wear comfortable clothing. Costumes will be made available in your holding area

END OF THE SHOW- pickup

- At the end of the show, **students will return to their designated holding areas** where they will change back into their comfortable clothing
- JDC students will not need to change, they will return home with their black t-shirt and black bike shorts ready for the next night
- **You are required to sign your daughter out before leaving Shelford.** After the show, please proceed to your daughter's designated holding area for pickup. A staff member will be there to sign your daughter out

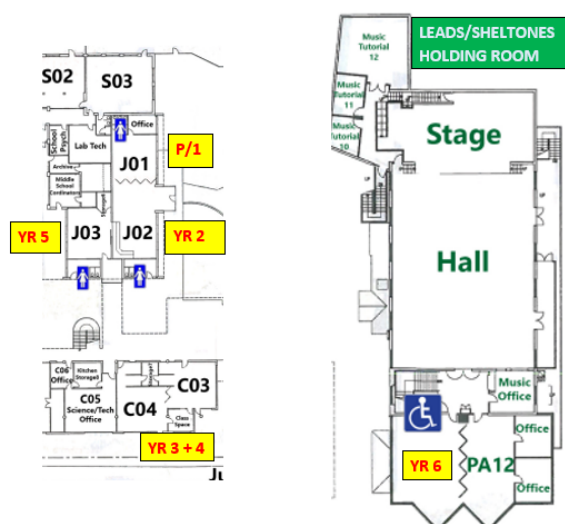
