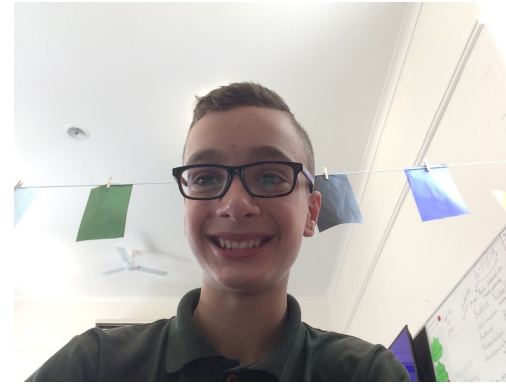


Hi, my name is Jufia.

What I will take away with me is... What I will miss... is how everybody knows each other

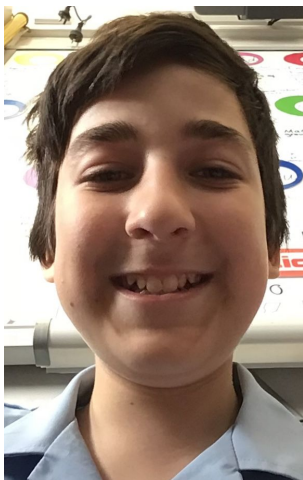


Hi my name is Sebastian

Hi my name is Chrysanthi IA

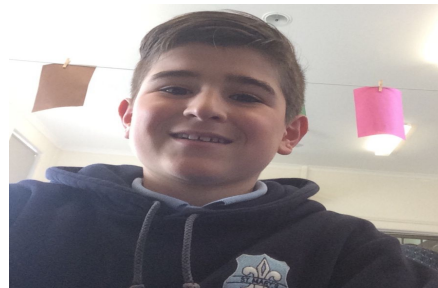

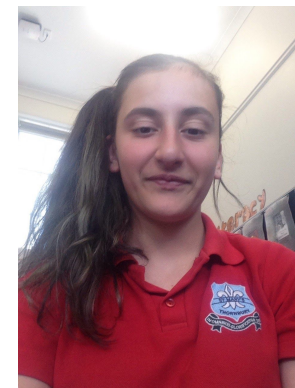
and to always think outside the box. I will miss

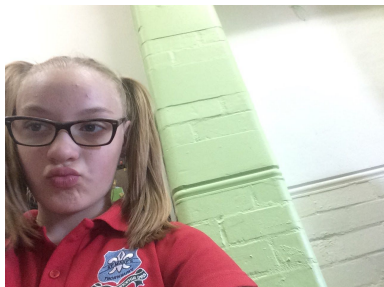

What I will miss... friends that I grew up with and their personalities.

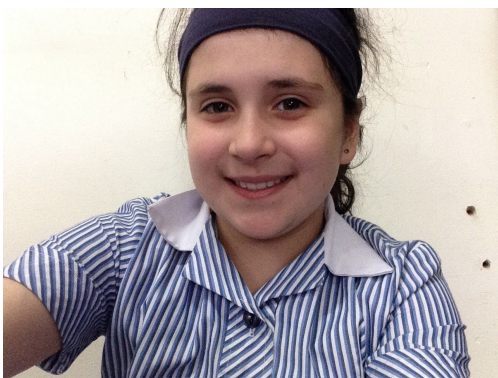
Hi my name is Yasmin

Hi my name is Grace

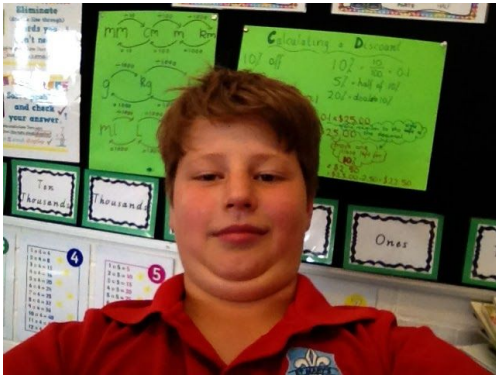
What I liked best about being at St Mary's was...making friends that are always there for me and make me laugh and all the opportunities there is for me to do.
