Safeguarding training and compliance requirements were introduced across parishes throughout Australia three years ago. As this training is required to be renewed every three years, all volunteers are now asked to ensure their compliance is up to date. Again, this weekend, all volunteers are requested to check the expiry date of their **Working with Children Check** card. If your card has expired, please renew it online at www.vic.gov.au/working-with-children-check.

All volunteers are also required to complete or renew their Safeguarding training, which is available online at: <https://melbournecatholic.org/safeguarding>

To assist those who may experience difficulties accessing or completing the online training, in-person training sessions will be offered in the coming months. Further details will be provided as they become available.

As part of the parish's Safeguarding compliance requirements, all volunteers are also asked to read and sign the **Code of Conduct**, which is available from the parish office.
