Vacation Care Program Information

Location: St Simons Primary School OSHC Building

Operating hours and late pickups:

- The Program commences at 7.00am and finishes at 6.30pm, daily. A late fee of \$25.00 per every 10 minutes will be charged if children are collected after 6.30pm please notify the Staff by 9.00 am if your child will not be attending.

Cost:

- Standard fee: \$65.00 per day per child (\$9.75 with Max CCS coverage*)
- Casual fee: \$70.00 per day per child (\$10.50 with Max CCS coverage*)
- Child Care Subsidy (CCS) discounted fees per child per day depending on your percentage of entitlements. To qualify your family needs to have completed the activity test online.
- Excursion/Incursion costs are covered by the CCS. Incursion cost is \$20.00 in addition to the daily fees and Excursion cost is \$30.00 in addition to the daily fees.

Booking Conditions:

- Bookings will not be processed without a completed enrolment and full payment for days required.
- To be eligible for CCS discount families need to call Centrelink.
- Bookings without the child care subsidy will be charged full fee. Subsidy will be refunded once successfully linked.

Booking Procedure:

- You must be enrolled into the program to be able to make a booking. Please ensure that all details are current, especially health details, contact details and custody details.

Payments:

- The primary parent (linked with CCS) is able to complete the auto debit set up via Xplor for payment.

Refunds/ Credits

- No refunds will be given for changes/cancellation made after the last day of term.
- A credit for future care will be issued, at the discretion of management, for absences as a result of illness. A medical certificate is required. Credit notes will be issued upon receipt of an application for credit which can be obtained by contacting the office on 0478 746 473.
- Credits will not be given if personal circumstances change.
- Cancellations made the week before the beginning of the program will incur a cancellation fee. There will be no refunds for changed or cancelled Vacation Care Bookings after the last day of the school term.

Required Daily:

- Adequate food for morning tea, afternoon tea and lunch. Drink bottle is essential.
- Due to Food Handling Regulations, our staffs are not allowed to cook or reheat food.
- Dress appropriate for the weather/activities. Sunscreen for outdoor play and a wide brimmed hat. Closed toed shoes must be worn for safety reasons.
- Risk minimizations are conducted for excursions/incursions and are available on request.
- Toys and electronics from home are welcome but staff cannot take responsibility for lost or broken toys and electronics. Please label all items brought to the program.

Authorization:

I authorise my child/ren to attend the VACATION CARE PROGRAM including the incursions/excursions to which my child has been enrolled.

- I approve of the enrolment and agree to abide by the rules and conditions of the program. I agree that St Simons OSHC and staff are to be free and clear of all responsibilities for an accident or loss of property during my child's participation in an activity at the Program.
