what is early entry?

YOU COULD GET AN OFFER BEFORE YOU SIT YOUR ATAR EXAMS

If you're successful, you'll get an offer much sooner than you would through the traditional university application process.

Many of the programs will give you an offer in August, September, or October, well before your exams start. Some will process your application and get back to you within a week or two.

YOU APPLY EARLIER IN THE YEAR

Some Universities and Tertiary Admissions Centres (TACs) have programs that allow you to apply earlier in the year.

Some are already open, others allow you to apply any time and give you an answer almost straight away.

You could receive a conditional (or guaranteed) offer before you've sat your final exams and well before the main December and January offer rounds, when the majority of your cohort will get their offers.

YOU CAN STILL APPLY THE 'NORMAL' WAY

You can get an early offer and in many cases still apply through the normal application process, which should give you more options to choose from.

Rather than simply hoping you get your first preference, you'll be able to apply for multiple programs, then when you have all your offers, you can decide where to go.

NOT ALL PROGRAMS THAT OPEN EARLY GIVE YOU AN EARLY OFFER

The Early Entry Programs are different from entry programs for specialised courses such as Teaching, which require you to apply early but won't give you an early offer.

These options have been excluded from our Early Entry Guide and we've focused on those where you could receive an offer before the main December offer round.

early entry could be for you if you...



have good marks



have sporting achievements



are recommended by your school



are an artist or musician



are active in your community



are a rural applicant



have leadership experience



have been disadvantaged

The selection board will look at a combination of factors including your results, any awards or achievements you've received, test results, auditions, portfolios and more to decide if they want to make you an early offer.

You may still have time to improve your application and increase your chances of getting a place, so it's a good idea to keep nurturing your extra-curricular and community activities throughout the year.

Every program is different, and they all have different eligibility criteria, so check that you meet the criteria before you start your application. If you don't meet the criteria, either find another program or apply through the traditional pathways.

Not every university offers an Early Entry program, so if you can't find a program from the university you want to attend then you may need to apply as per normal.

That's totally ok - university isn't for everyone, and it's wise to keep your options open as you approach the end of school.

Even if you're not sure if you want to go to university, you can still apply for Early Entry programs.

That way, if/when you get your offers you can make an informed decision about the available pathways. If you decide to start an apprenticeship or traineeship, or to go straight into work, then at least you'll have had the power to choose.

There are loads of other great pathways that don't involve university, and you should always carefully consider if university is the right path for you.

If you're not sure where to start then make a time to speak with your Careers Advisor or Year Level Coordinator, as they may be able to help you clarify your options.

early entry vs alternative entry

early entry

You can usually submit an application and receive an offer (conditional or guaranteed) into a course before you have sat your Year 12 final exams.

Early Entry is often (but not always) merit based, for students who stand out above the crowd with things like:

- Principal's recommendation
- Academic results
- Leadership or community engagement
- Other achievements



alternative entry

Enables you to achieve your goals even if you didn't get the ATAR you wanted, didn't receive an offer for the course you wanted, or didn't complete Year 12.

Alternative Entry Programs include:

- Bridging and Foundation courses
- Adjustment Factors
- Access Schemes
- Internal Transfers
- External Transfers
- Specialised Testing e.g. STAT
- Portfolio Applications
- Indigenous Access Programs



the application process

If you're thinking that you'd like an early offer then you need to learn about the application process. It's not quick, especially if you're going to apply for more than one program, so be prepared to fill in a fair bit of paperwork.

The good news is that this is good practice for once you leave school, when you'll need to apply for lots of different things.

If you don't have a portfolio of your achievements then now is a good time to put one together. Start by collecting all your certificates and awards into the one place - everything counts at this stage - then make a list of all your achievements in order from newest to oldest.

You may need to get a copy of your reports and any recent assessment scores - even though you won't need your ATAR right now (which is good, because you don't have it), the universities are likely to want to see how you are performing and if there have been any changes.

They'll also be keen to see if you're ready for university, so you may need a letter of recommendation or you may need to sit for an interview.

If you need a letter of recommendation then make sure you ask the person with plenty of time left, as they are probably busy and it may take them a little while to draft the letter.

track your application

Just as every program has different dates, benefits and eligibility criteria, each program also has a different application process. The good news is that there are some similarities across the programs, so you can follow these steps and skip any that don't apply for your program.

step 1 - find one or more programs to apply for

Do you want to go to that university, and can you study the courses you'd like there? Is the program still open?

step 2 - check if you are eligible

Do you have evidence of your achievements or to prove that you meet the eligibility criteria? If you're not sure reach out to the university to check before you apply.

step 3 - gather the paperwork

You'll need to fill in an application, and may need to supply supporting documents. If you need a recommendation from a teacher or your Principal get that as well.

Completed:

step 4 - apply to the right organisation

Do you need to apply directly to the university, or through a TAC? Make sure you apply on time, and pay any fees if there are any.

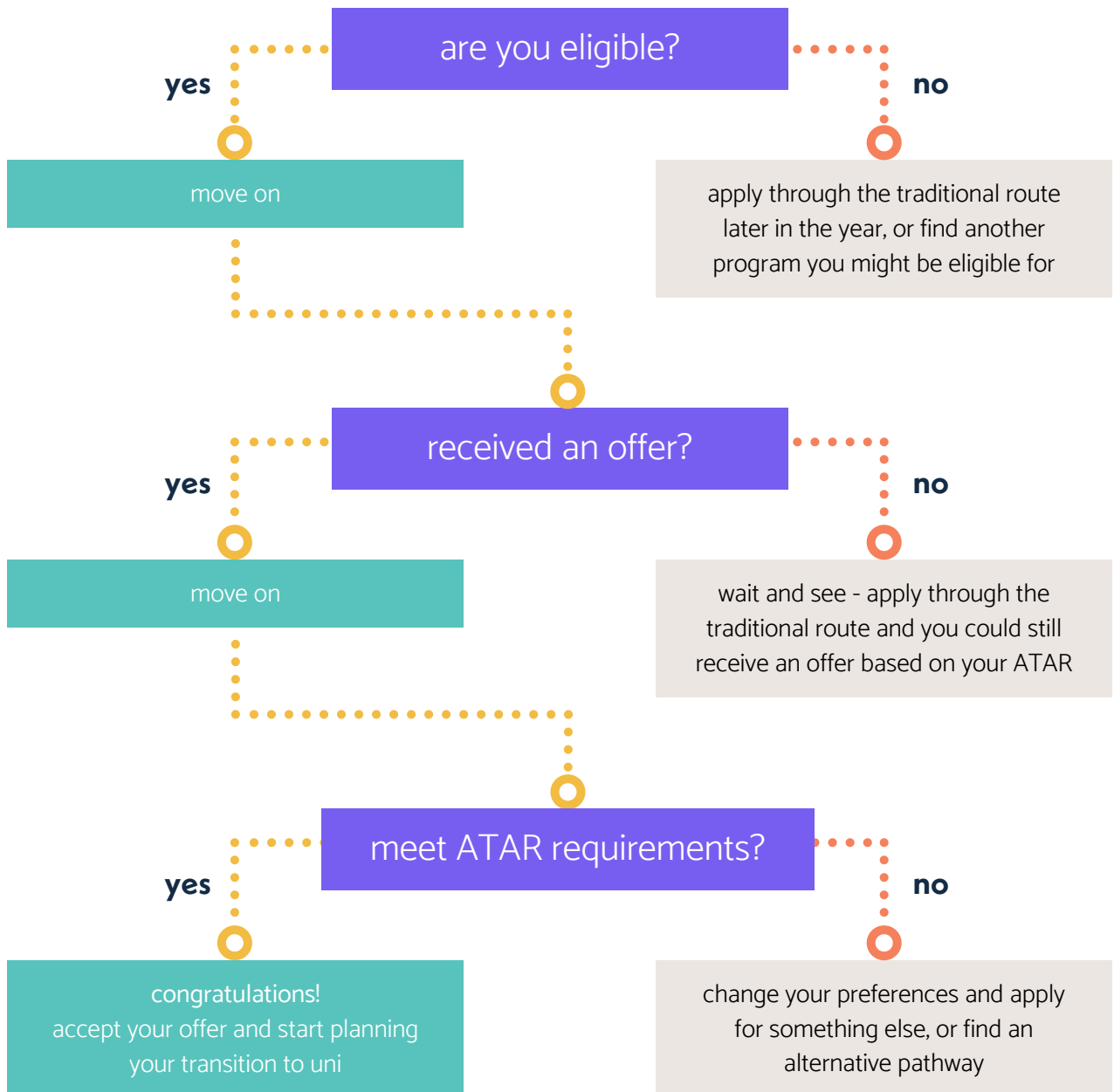

ACU Guarantee is open to all Year 12 students finishing high school in 2023. You can get a guaranteed offer to ACU before you sit exams. Offers are made based on Year 11 results, and offers can be deferred. Adjustment factors may also be granted based on rurality, school's relationship with ACU, ATSI status, and whether you are the first in your family to attend university.

To be eligible, you must be completing Year 12 in 2023. Apply online direct to ACU.

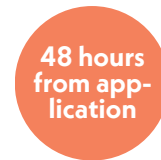

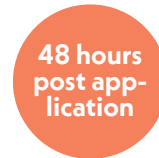

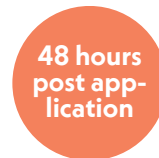
