Phillipa Mannix adds Australian Schoolgirls to already-bulging representative resume.

The Kinross Wolaroi School student helped her NSW side win the gold medal at the Gold Coast, and was named in the All Australian team as a result.

After wins over Tasmania (2-nil), South Australia (11-nil), ACT (6-1), Victoria (1-nil) and Western Australia (3-nil) NSW, coached by AICES coach and former Hockeyroo Jade Georgiou, took down Queensland in the gold medal game, prevailing in a sudden-death shootout.
