Reading

How much time is spent swimming altogether (not including lunch)?

Angles

At 3 o'clock, the hands of a clock make a right angle.

At what time will the clock next show a right angle?

A pizza is cut into 4 equal slices.

What is the angle at the centre of each slice?

A square has 4 corners.

What is the value of 1 corner angle?

What is the total of all the angles in the square?
