






Dear Parent/Caregiver

Your child is eligible for free vaccinations at school, protecting them against serious diseases.

Year 10 students (during terms 1 or 2) will be offered:

- 1  of menACWY vaccine (meningococcal ACWY).

Year 7 students (during terms 2, 3 or 4) will be offered:

- 1  of adolescent booster dTpa vaccine (diphtheria, tetanus and whooping cough)
- 1  of HPV vaccine (human Papillomavirus).
