The bee flies and lands on another flower.

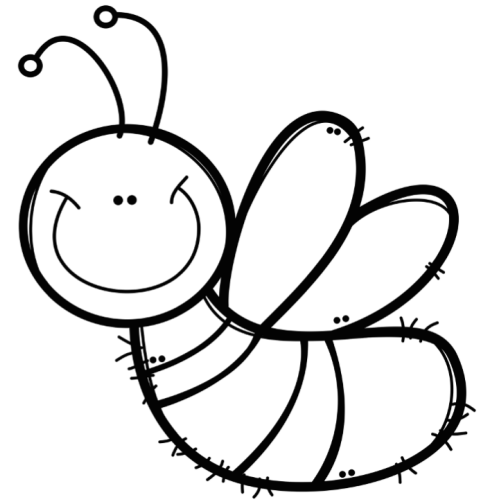
A bee flies and lands on a flower.

Some pollen falls off and lands on this flower. The pollen helps to pollenate the flower so a new flower can be grown.


Some pollen from the flower gets stuck to the bee.
