

AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship

The AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship is awarded to CSP students studying an **agriculturerelated undergraduate degree** or a Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths/Finance (STEM) degree with relevant majors which align to agriculture.

In partnership with industry sponsors, the AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship is an initiative supporting students enrolled in full time study at an Australian university by providing:

- A bursary of \$5000 per year for the final two years of your degree
- Professional development workshops
- Annual industry work placements aligned with the scholar's areas of interest and their sponsor's industry
- Opportunities to network and gain knowledge at a range of industry events.

To be eligible, students should be considering studying a degree related to agriculture, such as:

- Agricultural Science
- Rural Science
- Livestock/Animal Science
- Veterinary Science
- Agribusiness
- Plant Science
- Agricultural Economics

- Resource Management
- Sustainability
- Food Security
- Agricultural Economics
- Science, Technology, Engineering or Maths (STEM) – aligned with agriculture

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of their commitment to a career in agriculture, as well as their leadership potential and high school academic record. To be eligible for the AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship, students must be enrolled full-time in their **last two years** of an agriculture-related undergraduate degree at an Australian university.

APPEA Oil & Gas Industry Engineering Scholarship

The Tony Noon Scholarship is open to all Australian residents who are already undertaking a degree, with an aim to one-day work in the **petroleum industry**. Current Year 12 students are encouraged to flag this scholarship and apply in the August of the year relevant to them. Applicants must be enrolled in Honours, Masters, or PhD

Catherine McAuley Scholarship

Valued at up to \$10,000 and on offer to a CSP student applying to study **any undergraduate degree** within the Faculty of Health Sciences, Education and Arts or Law and Business at the <u>Brisbane Campus</u>. An <u>online application</u> is required, and applicants will be assessed based on the strength of the following criteria:

- Written statement
- Evidence of contribution to community service or leadership
- Letter of Recommendation

Global Excellence Scholarship for International Students

Valued at up to \$20,000 and on offer to International students commencing business and information technology courses. No application is required; all students applying to study business, or IT will automatically be considered.

George Alexander Foundation Scholarships

Valued at \$24,000 and on offer to CSP students applying for **any undergraduate degree** at the <u>Ballarat, Blacktown, North Sydney or Strathfield Campuses</u>. A minimum ATAR of 75.00 is required, and students will also be assessed based on the strength of the

following criteria when making an online application:

- Written statement
- Values statement
- Academic merit
- Leadership and community participation
- Resume
- Letters of recommendation

Ramsay Scholarship

Established in 2020, this scholarship supports commencing CSP students who attain an ATAR of 92.00+ and enrol full-time in the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)</u> OR the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)/Bachelor of Laws</u> OR the <u>Bachelor of Arts</u> (Western Civilisation)/Master of Teaching (Secondary) at the <u>North Sydney Campus</u>. Valued between \$90,000 and \$160,000 and will be paid in instalments of \$16,000 per semester. <u>Online applications</u> for the Ramsay Scholarship for 2024 will open in August. Thomas More Law School Academic Excellence Scholarship (pending)

This scholarship reflects ACU's commitment to academic excellence in any undergraduate **law and/or criminology and criminal justice degree**, and is valued at \$10,000 and on offer to eligible CSP students. <u>Online applications</u> are assessed based on the strength of the following criteria:

- Academic merit (based on ACU GPA)
- Written statement
- Letters of recommendation
- Interview

Australian National University

Range of scholarships each year, each ranging between \$1,000 and \$20,000, some once-off payments and others per year. Some of these include -

National University Scholarship

Awarded to eligible CSP students who have achieved an ATAR of 99.90 and above, **across all faculties**. No application is required. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered. Scholarship valued at \$12,500 per year, for a maximum of five years.

* ANU All-Rounder Scholarship

The ANU All-rounder Scholarship with the aim of acknowledging the achievement of those *applicants who were unsuccessful in the final stage of the Tuckwell Scholarship process* and offering them financial support to study at ANU. Valued at \$8,000 per annum for up to 4 years, and on offer to CSP students. No application is required as students are automatically considered based on them attaining a minimum ATAR of 90.00 and meeting the eligibility criteria or conditions prescribed under the Eligibility section.

* ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship

Awardees receive a tuition deduction of between 25% and 50% (fee waiver), and these scholarships are awarded to eligible International students who receive an offer to commence **any eligible undergraduate degree** in 2024 (except Doctor Of Medicine and Surgery (MChD). There are various categories of these scholarships, and no separate application is required as applicants are automatically considered based on them meeting the eligibility criteria.

College of Business and Economics National Excellence Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 per annum up to four years, and available to CSP students who have made an application for admission to a single, or a flexible double undergraduate degree program offered by the ANU College of Business and Economics; and have attained a minimum ATAR of 95. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered.

College of Engineering, Computing & Cybernetics Advanced Computing Research & Development Excellence Scholarship for Women.

CSP students who have applied for the **Bachelor of Advanced Computing (Research & Development) (Honours)**, and expect a minimum ATAR 99.00, are eligible to apply for this scholarship, valued at \$15,000 per annum paid over three years. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered.

 <u>College of Engineering, Computing & Cybernetics Engineering Research &</u> <u>Development Excellence Scholarship for Women.</u>

CSP students who have applied for the **Bachelor of Engineering (Research & Development) (Honours)**, and expect a minimum ATAR 99.00, are eligible to apply for

this scholarship, valued at \$15,000 per annum paid over three years. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered.

ANU Science Olympiad Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 per annum over three years, and on offer to CSP <u>and</u> International students who have represented Australia and been awarded a Gold Medal in the International Science Olympiad in one of the following areas - Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, Geography, Mathematics or Physics. Eligible students must attain a minimum ATAR of 95.00, and apply to enroll in a course offered by the ANU College of Science or the ANU College of Health and Medicine. Christel Larko Music Scholarship

A one-off \$10,000 scholarship on offer to eligible CSP <u>and</u> International students enrolling in the first year of an undergraduate degree program, specialising in either classical or jazz voice or keyboard in a program offered by the ANU School of Music. Selection is made on the basis of applicants meeting the eligibility criteria, and achieving a high score at audition, as determined by the ANU School of Music performance audition selection panel. No separate application is required as all students who audition will be considered.

Crompton Undergraduate Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 over one year, and open to CSP <u>and</u> International students enrolling in the first year of an undergraduate degree program at ANU School of **Music, majoring in keyboard**, and who receives a final selection mark of 70 or above at the audition. No application is required. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered.

Dean's International Science Excellence Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 over one year, and open to International students applying to **study science at the ANU**. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Dennis Griffin Piano Undergraduate Scholarships

Applicants must have received an offer by the School of Music in the **piano and composition** area of the School of Music. No application required as all new undergraduate students – CSP <u>and</u> International – will be automatically considered. Students must demonstrate outstanding musical ability and accomplishment, which will be assessed at the audition. Scholarship valued at \$5,000 per annum over three years.

Research School of Finance, Actuarial Studies & Statistics Bachelor of Finance, Economics & Statistics (Honours) Scholarship

Awarded to CSP <u>and</u> International students with a minimum ATAR of 99.00 and entering the **Bachelor of Finance, Economics, and Statistics (Honours)**. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered. Scholarship valued at \$10,000 – paid in two instalments over one year.

Vice-Chancellor's Elite Scholarships

This 100% scholarship is available to all Year 12 students with an ATAR above 95.00: with exceptional academic achievement, proven leadership ability and personal character, and extensive involvement in extra-curricular activities. Open to all undergraduate degrees excluding the Bond Medical Program. Applications are open and close Tuesday 1 August 2023.

Excellence Scholarships

Awarded to eligible Year 12 students with an ATAR of over 92.00, demonstrating high academic achievement, as well as leadership skills and community involvement. Excellence Scholarships cover up to 50% tuition for any single or approved combined undergraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program).

Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarships

Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarships are awarded exclusively to a Year 12 students who have participated in the Bond University National High School Mooting Competition. In addition, students must demonstrate high academic achievements, as well as demonstrated record of leadership, initiative and service to their School and/or Community. Students are expected to attain an ATAR of 92.00 and intend studying law.

Leadership Scholarship

The Bond University Leadership Scholarship aims to recognise current Year 12 students who have demonstrated high academic achievement, as well as outstanding leadership skills and community achievements, with a 25% tuition remission scholarship, for **any single or approved combined undergraduate degree** (excluding the Bond Medical Program). Students who are predicted to achieve an ATAR above 84.00 are eligible to apply.

✤ Transformer Scholarship

The <u>Transformer</u> is a co-curricular program offering at Bond designed to enable students to innovatively tackle real-world problems that matter. It is a program that attracts motivated, self-directed individuals who want to work in collaborative, interdisciplinary teams on challenging projects that typically span multiple semesters. Transformer Scholarships are awarded annually to students beginning their Bachelor's degree or Master's degree study at Bond University in the following year, January semester. Transformer Scholarships offer up to 50% tuition remission for **any single undergraduate** Bachelor's degree or postgraduate Master's degree program (excluding the Bond Medical Program) and are awarded to students who have high potential to affect real change through participation in the Transformer program.

CoLab Industry Scholarships

A 25% tuition remission scholarship awarded to eligible students who anticipate attaining an ATAR of 80.00, and wish to study one of the following Transformation Degree programs:

- <u>Bachelor of Entrepreneurial Transformation</u>
- Bachelor of Digital Transformation
- Bachelor of Health Transformation
- <u>Bachelor of Legal Transformation</u>

Charles Allan Seymour Hawker Scholarship

Valued at \$60,000 over three years, and open to Australian citizens, the C.A.S. Hawker Scholarship commemorates the achievements of one of Australia's most respected pastoral pioneers who served with distinction in the First World War and went on to become a distinguished scholar and leading figure in the Federal Parliament prior to his tragic, and untimely death in an aircraft accident in 1938.

The scholarships have been awarded almost equally to male and female applicants. Scholarship holders have come from every sector of Australian society and graduated from government, catholic and private schools. The majority of scholarships are awarded to students entering their first year of university. Past awardees have studied **law, politics, economics, medicine, and arts**. Hawker Scholars are now working in Australia, Europe, the USA, and Asia.

Applications for the 2024 Hawker Scholarship open on 4 December 2023 and close early January 2024. Eligible students will be invited to apply, and applications close 15 November 2023.

International Student Merit Scholarship

Valued at 24% tuition fee reduction, and open to International students. This scholarship recognises and rewards excellence for eligible students applying to study at Charles Sturt University. There is no separate application as application for this scholarship will be automatically considered by the admissions team when students apply for an eligible course on an eligible campus.

Casella Family Brands Health Scholarship

Valued at \$10,000 and paid over two instalments in one year: open to CSP <u>and</u> International students applying for study at the <u>Wagga Wagga Campus</u> of CSU. Commencing students to have an ATAR score of 65.00 or above. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. The eligible courses are –

- Bachelor of Medical Radiation Science (with specialisations)
- Bachelor of Health Science (Mental Health)
- Bachelor of Nursing

The Roberton Scholarship

Valued between \$30,000 and \$40,000 and available to eligible CSP <u>and</u> International students commencing a **Bachelor of Agriculture** OR **Bachelor of Agricultural Science** OR **Bachelor of Agricultural Business Management** at the <u>Wagga Wagga campus</u>. Students who attain an ATAR of 70.00 and above will be eligible to be considered. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

The Costa Avocado Agricultural Scholarship

Valued at \$15,000 paid over three years, and open to all eligible CSP <u>and</u> International students commencing the **Bachelor of Agriculture** OR **Bachelor of Agricultural Science** OR **Bachelor of Horticulture** at the <u>Albury-Wodonga; Bathurst; Dubbo; Orange; Port</u> <u>Macquarie; Wagga Wagga campuses</u>. To be considered for this scholarship, it is preferable that the recipient will be available to undertake paid work during university holidays at the Costa Avocados Stuart Point location. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

CSU Pharmacy Foundation Scholarship

A one-off payment of \$5,000 to eligible CSP <u>and</u> International students entering the first year of the **Bachelor of Pharmacy** at the <u>Orange Campus</u> and have attained a minimum ATAR of 65.00. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Dr. Peter Hodgson Scholarship

Any first year CSP <u>and</u> International student studying **any course** at the <u>Bathurst Campus</u> and who attained an ATAR of 85.00 or above is eligible to apply. This scholarship is valued at \$5,000 and is a one-off payment. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

* Destination Australia Scholarship (pending approval)

This scholarship from Destination Australia – an Australian Government initiative – is designed to encourage students to study in regional Australia. Valued at \$15,000 per annum for up to four years, CSP students who apply for certain courses are eligible to

apply - <u>https://study.csu.edu.au/get-support/scholarships/find-</u> <u>scholarship/equity/destination-australia-scholarship</u>. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Dr Ron Camplin Scholarship OAM

Open to CSP <u>and</u> International students applying for **any course** at the <u>Bathurst Campus</u> and who attained an ATAR of 85.00 or above. The scholarship is valued at \$18,000, to be paid in \$3,000 instalments twice per year pending GPA of 5.0 or above is achieved and enrolment is ongoing. Applicants are required to submit a minimum 250-word essay on "Who is Ron Camplin?", and provide evidence of *sound academic achievement*, *community/regional involvement*, and *career goals and aspirations*.

<u>Note</u>: Applications open soon for most scholarships although closing dates may vary, so it is important to research the scholarships online, and note application procedures and deadlines.

A one-off \$6,000 cash payment will be given towards an eligible international study

Curtin International Scholarships - Australian Year 12 Scholarship

Business Innovation Scholarship

Valued at \$35,000 to \$80,000, depending on the course duration, this scholarship is awarded by the Vice-Chancellor to Australian undergraduate students whose exceptional academic achievements, proven experience and leadership has truly set them apart. CSP students who either attain an ATAR of 95.00+ OR are the dux of their school, are eligible.

The scholarship includes:

- 100% of Tuition fees
- 100% of Student Services and Amenities Fees

• participation in the Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program

An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Deakin Scholarship for Excellence

This scholarship rewards strong academic performance teamed with excellence in extracurricular activities, community service or leadership, or an ATAR of at least 85.00. This CSP scholarship includes \$5000 paid as cash or towards tuition fees per year, or towards student contributions (tuition fees) – the student may choose. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship

Awarded to International students and provides 50% - 100% towards tuition fees, as well as participation in the <u>Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program</u>, and priority place in on-campus accommodation (at own cost and subject to availability). An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

<u>Note</u>: Unsuccessful applicants of the Deakin Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship will automatically be considered for the Deakin International Scholarship.

Deakin International Scholarship

To be eligible, must be a commencing International student applying to enrol in a Deakin University undergraduate course. Successful students will receive 25% towards tuition fees. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Deakin STEM Scholarship for International Students

International students applying to study undergraduate courses in the disciplines of **architecture and built environment, engineering, information technology, science or environment** are encouraged to apply for the Deakin Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Scholarship. Recipients will receive a 20% reduction in tuition fees. Academic eligibility for VTAC International students is 5 points above the published lowest selection rank ATAR. No separate application is required, and all eligible students will automatically be considered.

IGNITED Scholarship (pending)

The IGNITED Scholarship has been created to ignite women's interest in industry areas traditionally dominated by men, including engineering, information technology and construction management.

Valued at \$10,000 per annum and open to CSP students applying to study **any undergraduate degree** at the University of Wollongong excluding Global Honours. Applicants must demonstrate evidence of leadership and extracurricular activities within their <u>online application</u>.

Diplomat Scholarship – International Students

Valued at 30% reduction in tuition fees for the minimum duration of an eligible course, and open to International students applying for any **undergraduate course** (excluding Doctor of Medicine, Nutrition and Dietetics, Exercise Science and Rehabilitation, Education, Social Work and Psychology) at UW. Applicants to the University are automatically considered for this scholarship and do not need to submit a separate application.

University Excellence Scholarships – International Students

Valued at 30% reduction in tuition fees for the minimum duration of an eligible course, and open to International students applying for any **undergraduate course** (excluding Doctor of Medicine, Nutrition Science, Nutrition and Dietetics, Exercise Science, Exercise Science and Rehabilitation, Education, Social Work and Psychology) at UW. Applicants to the University are automatically considered for this scholarship and do not need to submit a separate application.

UOW Ramsay Scholarship

Valued at \$32,000 per annum for up to five years, and open to CSP students who enrol in the **Bachelor of Arts in Western Civilisation** as a single degree or double degree. An <u>online application</u> is required and applications close 13 August 2023.

This time period is dependent on the student's degree length however it will not exceed more than four years. The amount will be paid fortnightly.

THE INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THIS RESOURCE IS A GUIDELINE FOR STUDENTS

It is a summary of many of the foremost <u>academic merit</u> scholarships on offer and it is important that students confirm specific details of the various scholarships, i.e., eligibility, and the closing dates for their application/s themselves.

Students should also check whether the scholarships they are applying for are <u>deferrable</u> or not.

It is also advantageous to visit the university websites regularly as they are frequently updated, and detail numerous other scholarships - *access & equity scholarships, sport, and accommodation scholarships* - not referred to in this resource.

Students should also note that not every tertiary institution is listed here. It is imperative that students are methodical in researching the websites of the institutions they are applying to themselves.

Where possible, reference has been made as to whether the scholarship is available to Commonwealth Supported Students (CSP) – referring to Australian citizens, <u>some New</u> Zealand citizens, and residents on Permanent Humanitarian Visas only – or whether it is open to International students too.

Students should double-check their eligibility themselves.
