What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a structured training arrangement of usually 3 or 4-years duration. The training combines practical experience at work with complementary off-the-job training with a Registered Training Organisation (RTO). In this case Swinburne University of Technology.

On successful completion, students are issued with a nationally recognised qualification as a qualified Tradesperson.

There is a high demand for apprentices in the Outer East, in carpentry, plumbing, electrical, horticulture, and bricklaying. Completing an apprenticeship is a great start to your career. It provides a solid foundation, regardless of whether you change your career direction later.

In-school pre-apprenticeship (Certificate II) pathways include:

- SBAT School Based Apprenticeship or Traineeship – on-the-job training with employer + structured training at RTO. Can then move to a full-time apprenticeship. Also, get paid. + <u>Apprenticeship Support Australia</u> <u>School-Based Apprenticeships</u>
- VETDSS program (Vocational Education Training Delivered to Secondary Students). Attend Swinburne one day a week over a 2year period. Talk to your school VET Coordinator.

Our qualified careers counsellors:

- Provide career guidance and career path exploration
- Provide course and apprenticeship information
- Link jobseekers with local employers carpentry, plumbing, electrical, bricklaying, horticulture and engineering (high industry demand)
- Offer job readiness support: cover letter, resume and interview preparation
- Work closely with student success coaches to re-engage out of trade apprentices with new employers

Student Success Coaches support vocational education students to better succeed in their studies. They work with students to assess their individual needs and design strategies to help students overcome challenges and to access the right support. VCE VM (Vocational Major)

- VCE VM replaces VCAL which retires at end 2022. Students who want vocational learning should ask for the Vocational Major (VCE VM) course
- In 2023 Swinburne Secondary Programs will deliver VCE VM, Units 1-4. They are VM Literacy, VM Numeracy, VM Personal Skills Development, VM Work Related Skills
- VCE VM is a 2-year VCE certificate. It has no end of year exams and does not produce an ATAR
- Available at Croydon and Wantirna
