PLEDGE CARD



One call. No questions asked.

Why didn't they call me?

Each student received a 'pledge card' and was encouraged to identify someone who they could call to pick them up if and when they find themselves in a potentially dangerous situation beyond their control.


A conversation and written promise to be there when you are most needed, with no questions asked, is a vital step towards ensuring our young people arrive home safe every night.

We want every young person to feel there is someone they can call to help them if they need.


DISTRACTED DRIVER

Set. Forget. No Regret

Mobile phone use is illegal for L and P plate drivers, and yet young people are four times more likely to drive distracted, using their phones. Students were encouraged to set their phones, then leave them alone...to send all their messages, and make all their calls before starting their drive. The importance of enabling 'Do Not Disturb While Driving' was also discussed with students encouraged to "Set. Forget. No Regret".



20/20 VISION



Do something. Say something.

If and when our young people find themselves in a dangerous situation as a passenger, we want them to see clearly what is happening around them, and ask themselves this question...

"Could something happen in the next **20 seconds** that could affect my next **20 years**?"

Students are encouraged to speak up if they find themselves in a situation that doesn't feel right.
