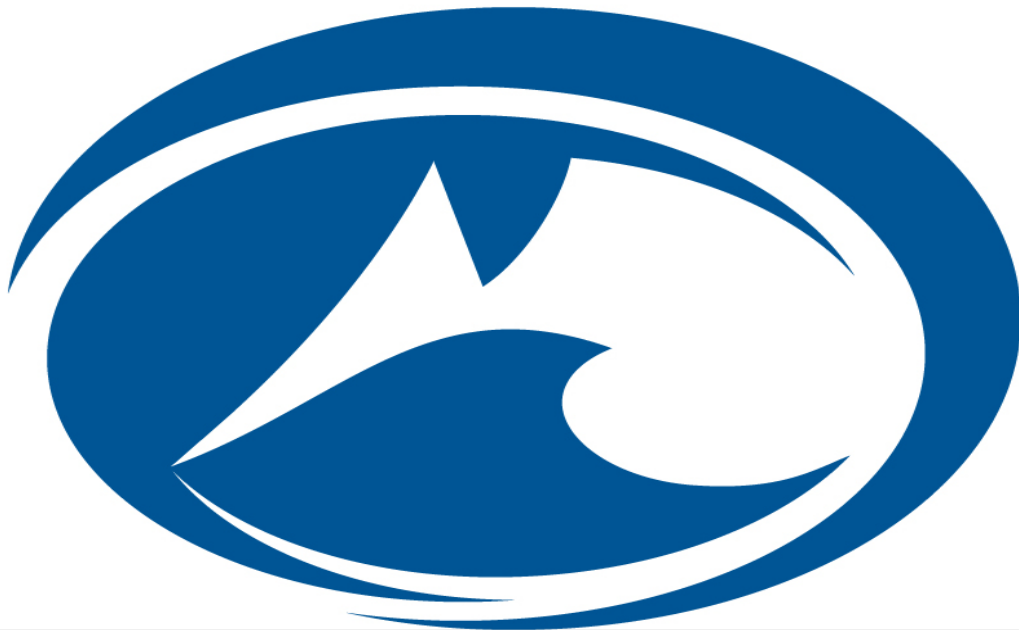

# Course Confirmation for 2019

This process is confirming your son/daughter's subjects for next year. If subjects are correct proceed to payments, if it's not correct your son/daughter will need to see their current Year Level Coordinator.

All parent payments for 2019 will be made via Compass, Course Confirmation. The link can be found, in either your "My News" section on the opening page or via the "Organisation"  menu.

Firstly, you will be prompted to answer a few questions. Eg Your son/daughter agrees to the College rules and values, uniform policy, permission to use photos, etc. Please note you can't continue unless you answer all questions.

## Completing Course Confirmation through Compass (Parents)

Firstly, families will be prompted to complete any agreements and questions that have been set up in the template. If the 'Parent to sign' or 'Student to sign' box has been ticked, the families will be prompted to digitally sign the agreements.

## Voluntary and Optional Payments

If paying by BPAY, complete and print invoice for your records and then BPAY as normal.
