Works alert – Bridge foundations and rail signalling works

Works are continuing on the Maroondah Highway level crossing removal project with strict health and safety protocols in place. The health and safety of our workers and the community will remain our key priority as we undertake works on the Maroondah Highway level crossing removal project. We will continue to follow the directions of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) as we safely complete works on this project.

This works alert provides an overview of the construction activities for the Maroondah Highway level crossing removal project that you may notice from week commencing **Monday 29 March 2021**.

Upcoming works

John Street and William Street East and West

- Piling pad construction and piling works will continue in various locations within the rail corridor at the corner of John Street and William Street East and West. There will be an increase in construction noise and vibration during this time.
- Large rigs, cranes, trucks and vibratory rollers will be in operation to install and compact earth material.
- Concrete demolition work will also be carried out within the rail corridor on William Street East. There will be an increase in construction noise and vibration while these works are carried out.

Maroondah Highway

- Installation of underground services will occur beside the footpath on the western side of the Maroondah Highway service road, near Olex.
- Traffic management will be in place to safely assist pedestrians to their destination.

What to expect

- All works are planned to be carried out during standard construction hours (7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm Saturday).
- Construction noise and activity, with an increase in construction vehicle movements, equipment and works operating in the area.
- Short stoppages at times on John Street to assist motorists while construction activities are carried out.
- Traffic management will be in place across various locations to safely assist road users and pedestrians to their destination.
