In 2024, EREA NSW Colleges commissioned an independent, confidential 'experience' survey of all school parents, staff and students at St Pius X College as part of our commitment to continually monitor and improve the quality of education we provide to our students.

This information is most important for the College for our operational and strategic planning, as well as for tracking changes in our performance and our continued improvement.


For the 2024 review, a total of 430 parents completed the survey.

The surveys were extensive and covered in excess of 300 aspects of education at the College.

Overview of Key Areas

The 'MMG Wheel' below reflects the average scores for parents across key areas.


Parents noted 'very high' scores for 5 of the 11 areas and 'high' scores for the remaining 6 areas. The overall score is 'high' (79%).





Expectations Met or Exceeded

The following charts detail the percentage of parents who noted their expectations had been met or exceeded across key areas, ranked in order of the importance they placed on these same areas when choosing the College for their sons. For example, 79% of parents noted their expectations had been met or exceeded for 'quality of teaching' – the noted most important area.

Expectations Met/Exceeded for Top 5 Most Important Areas


- 1. 79% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the quality of teaching
- 2. 87% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the focus on student wellbeing
- 3. 93% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to balanced education
- 4. 89% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to quality education at reasonable expense
- 5. 91% of parents noted their expectations were met or exceeded in relation to the College's reputation

The following chart shows parents' level of agreement with statements relating to the Academic Program at the College.


2024 St Pius X College Years 5-6 Parents - Agreement with Statements Relating to the Academic Program (n=88)

2024 St Pius X College Years 7-12 Parents - Agreement with Statements Relating to the Academic Program (n=342)




Son's Life at the College
