The school has been using the PERMA framework as school values. Staff felt this was not easily understood by students and suggested we have a value linked to each PERMA area.


In Term 4 staff worked in groups to brainstorm possible values. Based on the results of this, the top 4 values of each area were identified.

The principal put together a survey late in term 4 to canvass the ideas of the parent community. 74 responses were received.


Results




In the PERMA Framework 'E' means 'Engagement'. Which value would you choose to represent this? 74 responses




In the PERMA Framework 'R' means 'Relationships'. Which value would you choose to represent this?

74 responses




In the PERMA Framework 'M' means 'Meaning'. Which value would you choose to represent this? 74 responses
