**TRANSPORT:** Transport to and from QSAC will be by chartered bus. Students are to assemble at the Tuckshop area promptly at **7:20am** to have their name marked off the roll before departure. The bus will then return to Clayfield College, Bayview Terrace, at approximately **3:30pm** where students should be collected promptly.

Students may travel home with their parents/caregivers from the venue. Parents collecting their daughter at the conclusion of the carnival must meet the team at the North Rd entrance to the Stadium. Please refer to the attached map. Students must check out with a Clayfield College teacher before leaving. Students will be unable to wait for any Parent who is not at the entrance when the team departs. In this instance, students will travel back to the College on the bus with the rest of the team.
