

# Local Excursion Consent Form



Brinbeal Secondary College may take students outside of school grounds to undertake educational activities in the local area. This form does NOT provide consent for excursions that go beyond the local area.

**The purpose of this form is to obtain parent/carer consent for local excursions during the school year.**

## Local excursions

Local excursions are excursions to locations within walking distance of the school and do not involve 'Adventure Activities'.

Local excursions that your child may participate in throughout the year could include:

- Physical Education lessons at the exercise station on Connaught Rd – students will cross Connaught Rd and walk the short distance along the walking track and complete a fitness circuit.
- Science lessons at Werribee River – students will cross Connaught Rd and walk via Hogans and Davis Roads to reach the Werribee River to explore the ecosystems.
- Community service such as Clean-up Australia Day – students will walk around the local area to help clean up the area.

## Notification of local excursions

Brinbeal Secondary College will NOT seek further consent from you before local excursions take place. However, we will provide advance notice to parents/carers of upcoming local excursions via email and/or Compass newsfeed. For local excursions that occur on a recurring basis, Brinbeal Secondary College will notify parents/carers once only prior to the commencement of the recurring event, eg; weekly sports lessons at the local oval. Please keep the school informed of any updated contact details to ensure you receive these notifications.

## First aid and Medical Attention

Where necessary, school staff will administer first aid. School staff will also seek emergency medical attention for your child if it is considered reasonably necessary. Any costs associated with student injury rest with parents/carers unless the Department of Education and Training is liable in negligence (liability is not automatic).

## Accident and ambulance cover

The Department of Education and Training does not provide student accident insurance or ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain this cover, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations.
