Dear Parents/Carers of students in Years 10, 11 and 12,

Attached to this email, you will find your student's booklist. This booklist identifies the resources you will need to purchase for your child for the 2025 school year. As students reach the final years of school, they require more specific learning materials for the different subjects they elect to study. Therefore, it is more equitable for students to purchase the materials and textbooks they require, rather than asking families to contribute to a generic resource levy.

Students have been emailed their subjects for 2025. Please consult your students' subject list and identify the subjects on the booklist they require materials for. Our booklist provider is Champion Education. Champion offers a home delivery service. Orders placed by Friday 20 December will be delivered prior to the 2025 school year. However, you can place Click and Collect orders or visit their retail space at 13 Telford Dr, Shepparton VIC 3630, from now until the beginning of the school year. Texts identified as "New Edition for 2025" must be purchased new. This signifies the implementation of a new Study Design and previous editions of the text will not be suitable. Texts that are not new for 2025 can be purchased second hand. If you do purchase a text second hand, please ensure it is the current edition and your student will have access to the digital resources that accompany the text. Textbook providers often allow for multiple users of digital resources but the number of times an access code can be used varies between publishers.

### Jacaranda Digital Text Levy

The VCE Jacaranda Digital Text Levy must be purchased online through Champion by all students undertaking Year 10 and VCE. This resource gives students access to the full range of Jacaranda texts as well as videos, eWorkbooks, pracs, quizzes and assessments. **This resource is not optional and must be purchased.** Please support the College by ensuring payment is made prior to the beginning of the school year. Our finance team spend many hours attempting to settle unpaid accounts and your cooperation will assist them greatly. **Please note that VCE-VM students are not required to purchase this resource.**

### Edrolo

Information regarding account set up for Edrolo resources for VCE General Maths, VCE Biology and VCE History: Revolutions will be emailed to students. Students will set up their accounts during the Early Commencement Program. Once this account is set up, you will need to click on the payment link. We ask you support your student by making payment as soon as possible. Again, the finance team spend many hours chasing unpaid accounts and your cooperation will assist them greatly.
