Our journey through Greece will help us appreciate the spread of the Jesus movement into the Greek world and the role which Paul played in establishing early Jesus households. Our journey into Turkey will continue to track Paul. We add, though, another focus as we ponder the growth of the Jesus movement. We shall consider the final book of the New Testament, the Book of Revelation, and visit the seven churches in Asia Minor that it addresses.

Day 1: Tuesday 31st December 2024

Arrive Athens (D)

After arrival at the Athens airport, going through passport control and luggage collection, you will be met by your tour guide and you will be transferred to our hotel, where participants will gather together.

Day 2: Wednesday 1st January 2025

Athens (B,D)

After breakfast we have a city tour of Athens visiting the wonderful Athens Acropolis, Mars Hill, where Paul preached to the Athenians and the ancient Agora—market.

Day 3: Thursday 2nd January 2025

Corinth (B,D)

Visit Corinth and the archaeological sites and village of this ancient city. Marvel at the engineering feat of the Corinth Canal which these days is largely unused. Following this we head to the ancient ports of Cenchreae and Lechaion where Paul stopped on his second mission. Today we will also visit Mycenae, Nauplia and Epidaurus.

Day 4: Friday 3rd January 2025

Kalambaka (B,D)

Today we depart from Athens and visit Ossios Lucas and then continue and drive to visit Delphi. In the afternoon we drive to Kalambaka.

Day 5: Saturday 4th January 2025

Meteora (B,D)

Today we Visit Meteora Monasteries and then drive to Vergina. We pass by the Vegia (Beroa) and then travel to Thessaloniki.

Day 6: Sunday 5th January 2025

Thessaloniki (B,D)

Today we will enjoy a city tour of Thessaloniki.

Day 7: Monday 6th January 2025

Kavala (B,D)

This morning we visit the Arch and the museum in Thessaloniki. We then drive to visit Philippi. This afternoon we drive to Kavala.

Day 8: Tuesday 7th January 2025

Kavala-Turkey (B,D)

After breakfast we drive to the Greek/Turkey border.

Ride to the Dardanelles and cross the strait into the Asian side.

Accommodation: CANAKKALE, Kolin hotel

Day 9: Wednesday 8th January 2025

Canakkale (B,D)

Today we journey to the well-known WWI battle site of Gallipoli.

A ferry crossing at the Dardanelles will lead us to to the site and back to our hotel.

Day 10: Thursday 9th January 2025

Izmir (B,D)

In our visit to TROY we gain a sense of the marvels of archaeological research and what it uncovers. Our visit to ancient PERGAMON and its spectacular acropolis introduces us to the first of seven churches addressed by the last book of the Bible, the "Book of Revelation". Arrival to *IZMIR* ancient SMYRNA.

Day 11: Friday 10th January 2025

Izmir (R D)

We visit one of the most important sites of Asia Minor, EPHESUS. We shall also visit the traditional House of Mother MARY and the remains of the spectacular basilica dedicated to St John where tradition locates his grave.

Day 12: Saturday 11th January 2025

Pamukkale (B,D)

Site visits to SARDIS, PHILADELPHIA and continue to HIERAPOLIS for our reflection on the Book of Revelation

Day 13: Sunday 12th January 2025

Bursa (B,D)

After breakfast we visit LAODICEA and THYATIRA on the way to Bursa.

Accommodation: BURSA, Kervansaray Hotel

Day 14: Monday 13th January 2025

Istanbul (B,D)

Heading to Istanbul: We continue our journey to NICEA and visit the Museum, the St Sophia church, walls, and the Gates.

Accommodation: ISTANBUL, Millenium Golden Horn Hotel

Day 15: Tuesday 14th January 2025

Istanbul (B,D)

Our first full day in Istanbul is an orientation of the city. We will visit the main monuments around Hippodrome square. These include the Blue Mosque, Justinian's Cisterns, Archaeological Museum and the beautiful Hagia Sophia.

Istanbul (B,D)

Today we cruise on the Bosphorus and get a different view and insight into the history of Istanbul. A visit to the Egyptian Market along the Golden Horn will allow us to marvel at the walls of ancient Constantinople. A visit to the Greek Orthodox Patriarchate concludes our day.
