Dear Parents/Caregivers of Year 12 Students

Annual Speech Night

The Clayfield College Annual Speech Night is on Tuesday 16 November at 7pm in the Concert Hall at the Queensland Performing Arts Centre (QPAC). Year 12 students are required to attend, wearing school uniform (with blazers but no hats). The evening is a wonderful expression of the College community, providing an opportunity for students to develop dispositions associated with well-being and success. The evening will include an acknowledgement on stage of the girls' graduation from secondary school.

All Year 12 students, whether they are prize winners or not, are required to make their own way to QPAC Concert Hall by 8.30am on the morning of Tuesday 16 November to rehearse for the evening. Details regarding the organisation of the day are outlined below, and students are required to wear school uniform.

8:30am Year 12s who are also musicians enter through the QPAC Stage Door.

Year 12s who are not musicians should enter through the main reception area

and make their way to Door 5 of the Concert Hall.

8.40am – 11:00am Rehearsal of the Year 12 section of the program with Mrs Fellowes

Rehearsal of presentation of prizes

11:00am Year 12s, who are not required to stay, are dismissed to make their own way

home

11:00am - 11:30am Rehearsal of Passing of the Light (College Captains and Chapel Captains)

Musicians remain at QPAC

11:30am – 12:15pm Lunch break for Year 12 Musicians (own lunch must be brought)

12:15pm – 5:00pm Rehearsal of musical items

5:00pm - 6:00pm All students may pre-order a meal from QPAC. This pre-ordered dinner (\$14.50)

may be purchased online (see correspondence from Music Department). For COVID reasons, senior students are not permitted to leave QPAC to purchase

food in the Southbank area.

6:00pm Tune and Warm Up for instrumentalists

6:20pm Choristers to their seats on stage

6:30pm All Year 12s, who are not musicians, meet Ms Main outside Door 10 to collect

their tickets. Each girl has a seat allocated to her in the auditorium.

At the end of the evening, all musicians will leave via Stage Door, and all other Year 12s will leave via the auditorium and move to the foyer where they may be collected. For COVID capacity reasons, families are requested to move quickly through the foyer and use the outside space for socialising.
