



appeared.

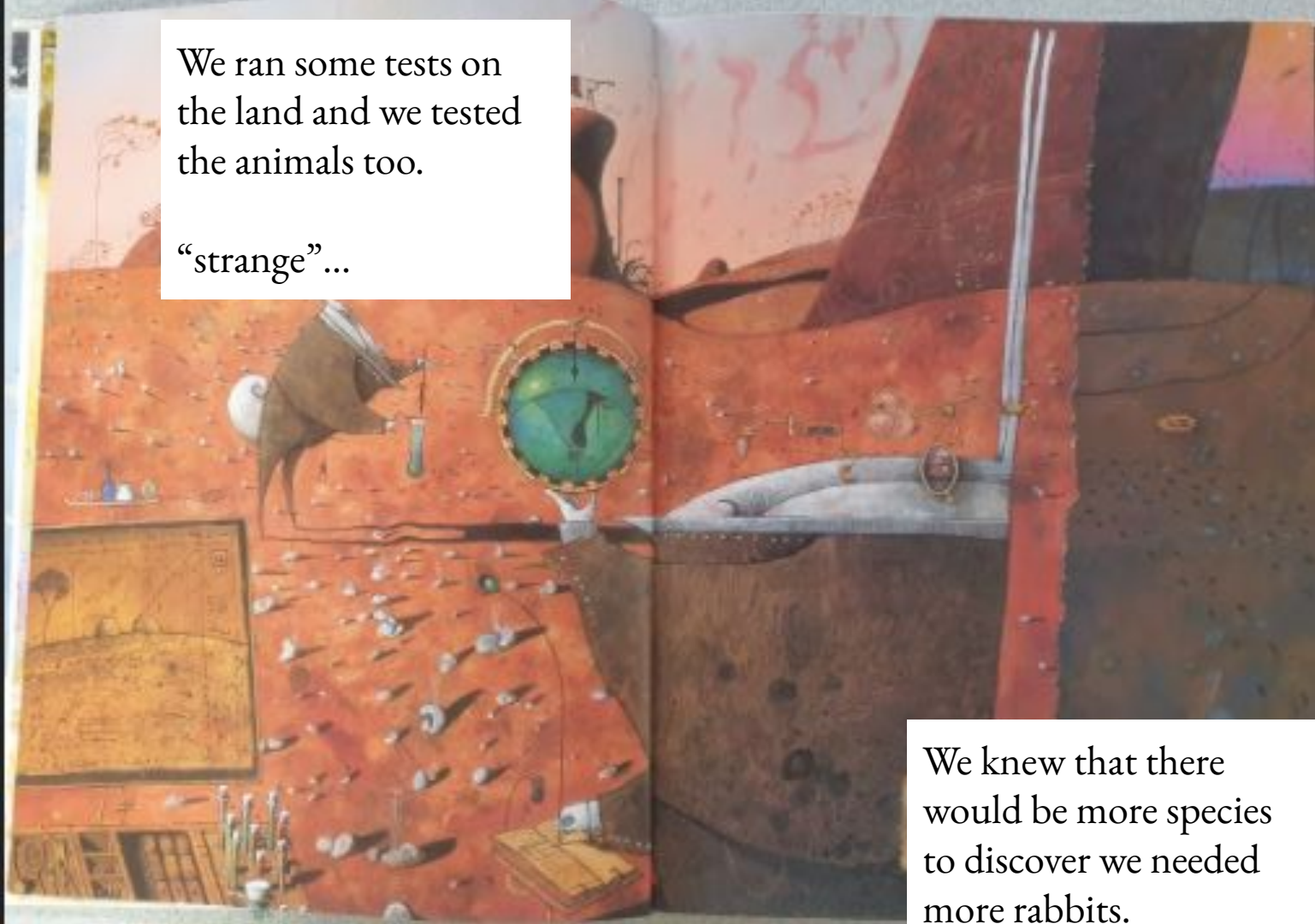


We saw the Native Animals they greeted us in a strange way we didn't expect.

“strange”...

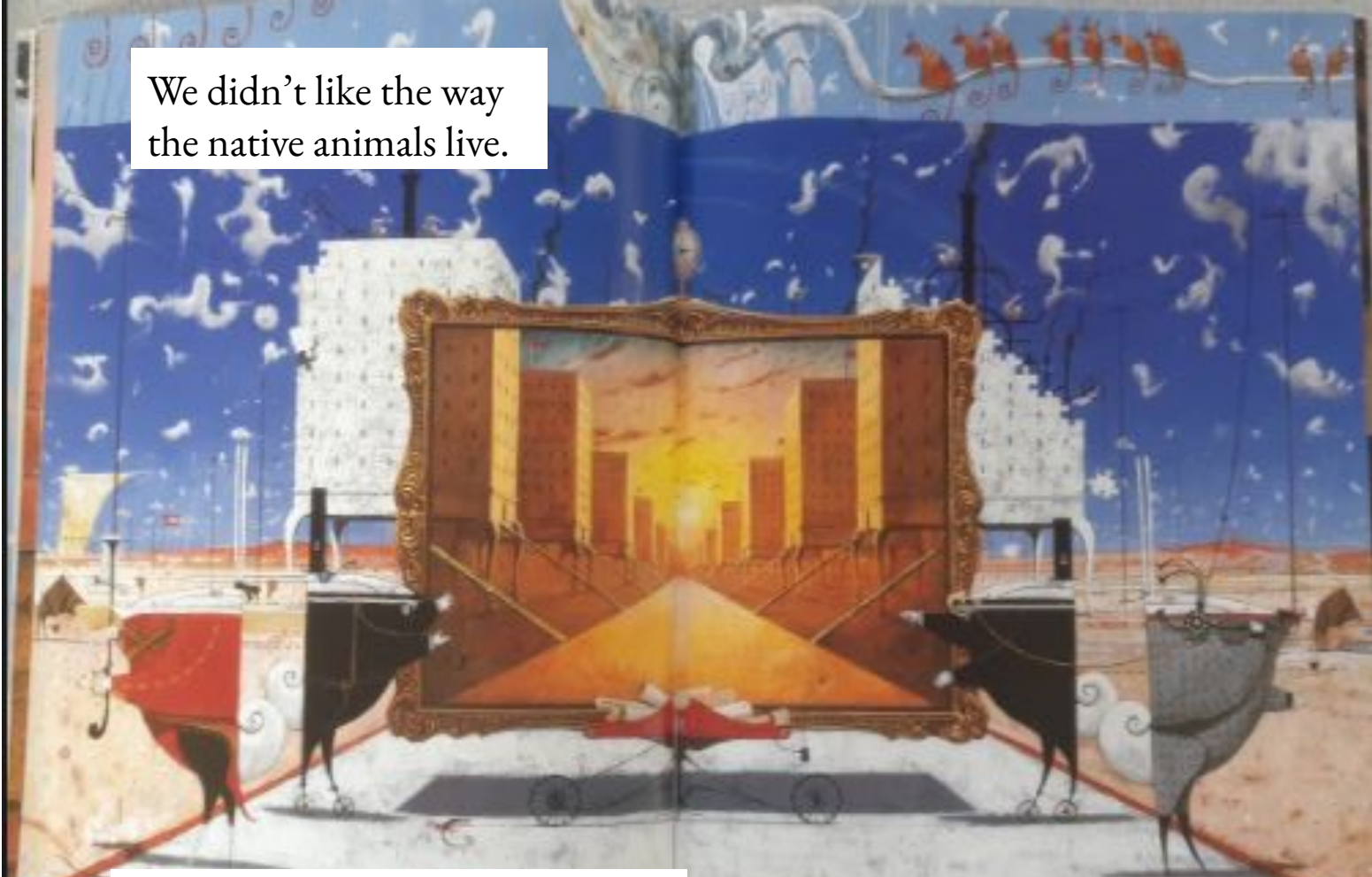


We knew that there

We needed a better home design.

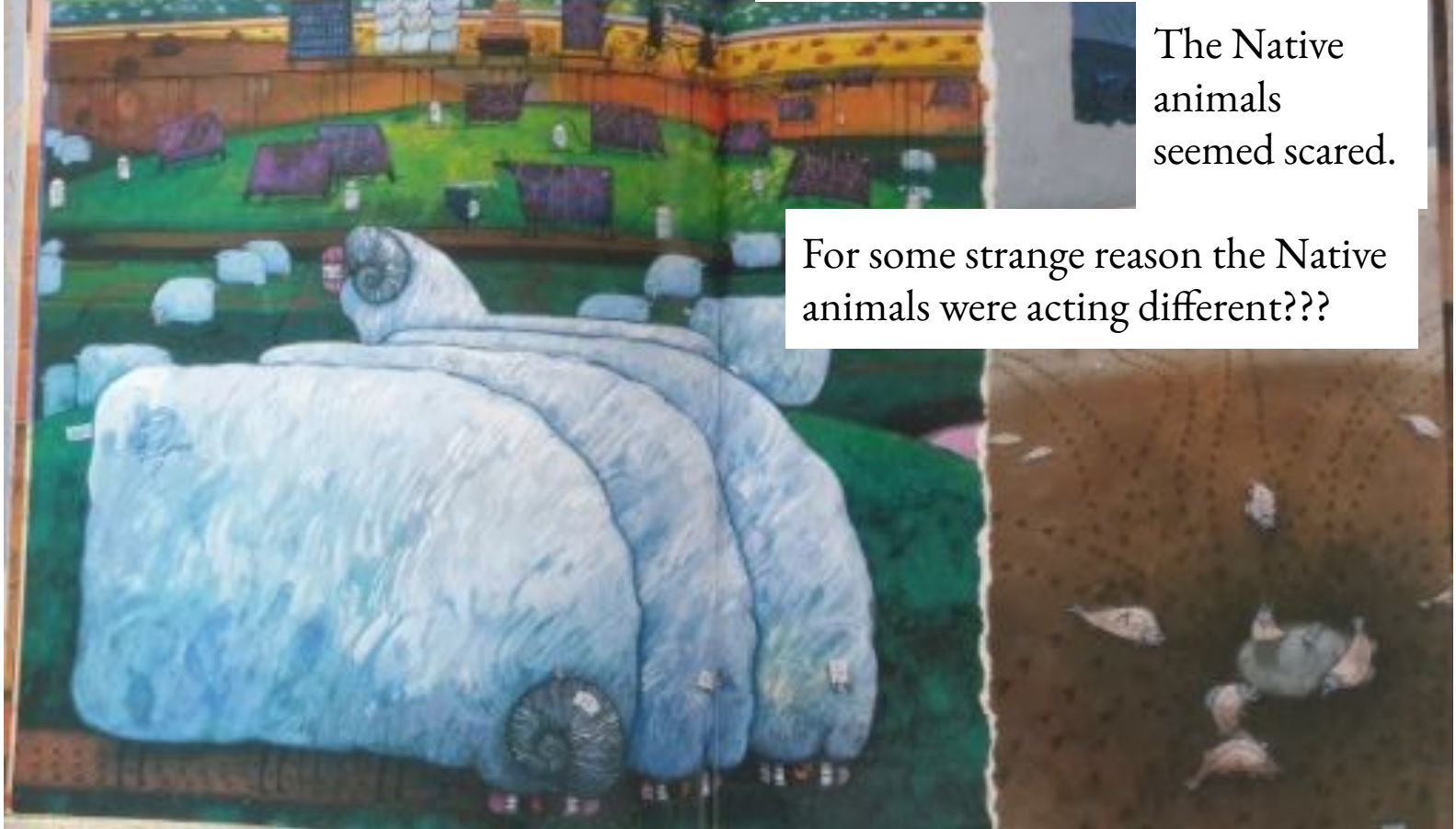
We showed our design to the other rabbits.

animals were acting different???





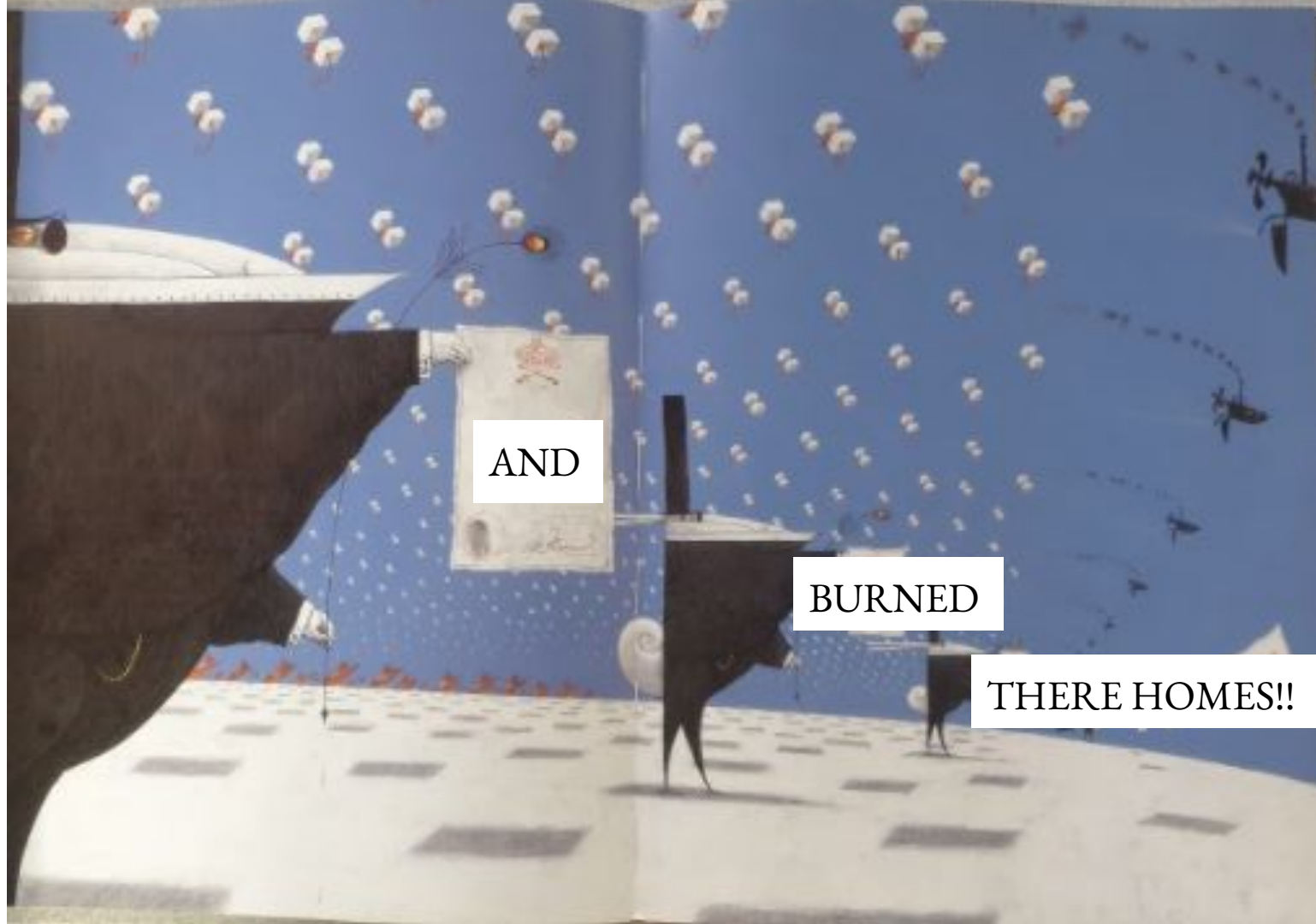
We traveled across the country discovering new things.

We ate all the grass in the land. We chopped down all of the trees.

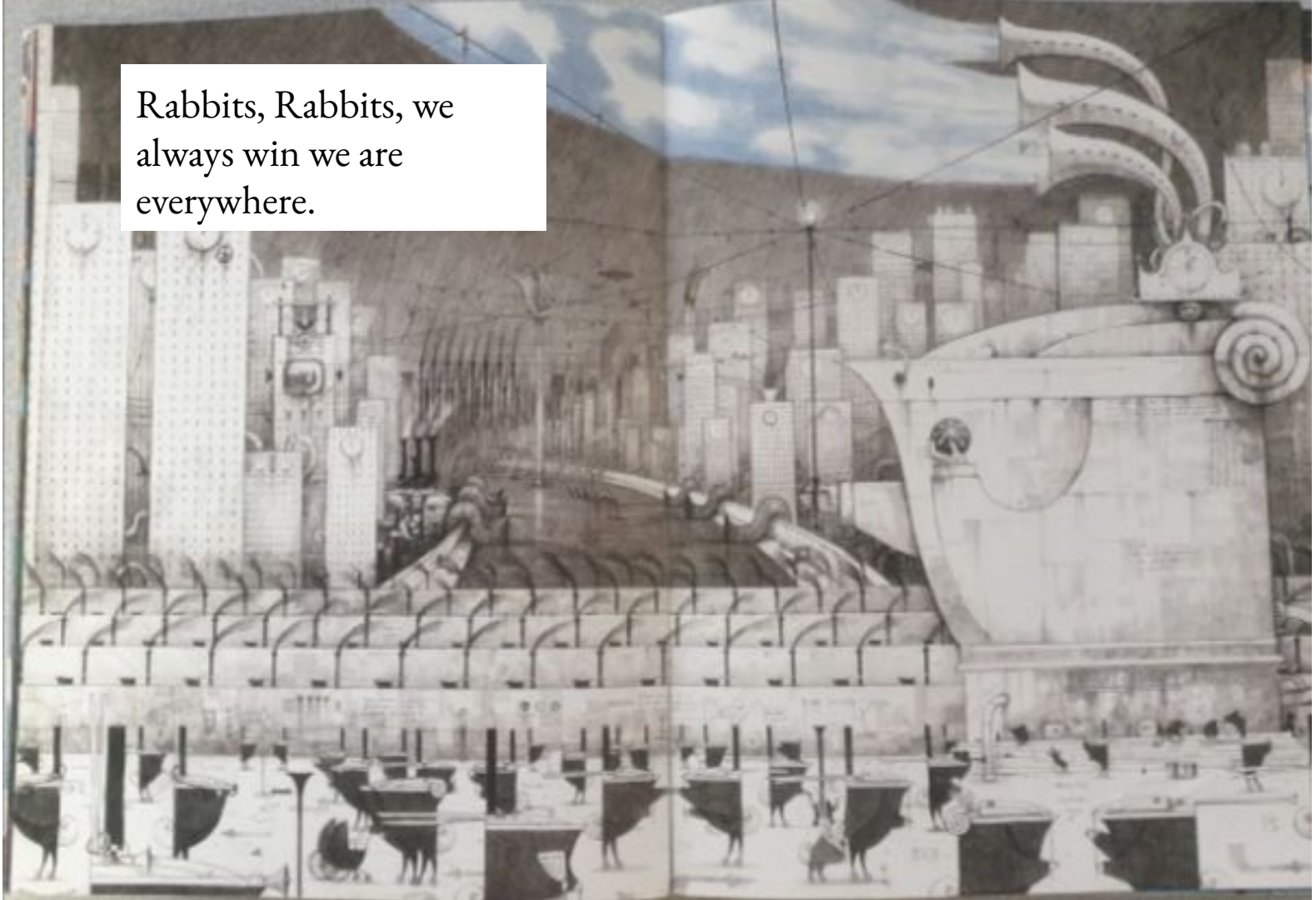
