## **PLEASE NOTE**

- Bring your own packed lunch and snack for the first day: Drink bottle, snack and lunch must be in a small backpack which will be taken on the bus with each student.
- Travel sickness medication needs to be given to a Teacher by parents before the trip
- Please ensure that all of your child's items are clearly labelled with their name
- All medication (including 2 x Epipen and Asthma medication) must be given to staff on the morning of departure and signed in. Medication and measuring devices must be clearly labelled with name and directions for use.
- Clothing: Campers must bring a long-sleeved non-synthetic (ie. wool or cotton) shirt or jumper, long trousers and a hat, as recommended by the Department of Education and the Country Fire Authority
- For Bed Wetters: Parents should pack an extra sleeping bag that can be safely dried in a commercial clothes dryer
- Suitcase/Luggage: We ask that students bring 1 backpack and 1 bag/suitcase and that they are able to carry these independently
