




SWPBS is a whole-school evidence-based framework that encourages a positive and inclusive environment, where students and staff can thrive. Students are explicitly taught Highvale Primary School behaviour expectations. All staff use the SWPBS flowchart to deal with student behaviour.

Expected behaviours are explicitly taught and highlighted through three core values, which are:

-  **Be Safe**
-  **Be Respectful**
-  **Be Your Best**

Expected behaviours are rewarded with hole punches in the associated card. When the student has filled their punch card with hole punches, they bring it to the office to place a star in the whole-school rewards jar.

### HOW WE DEAL WITH UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

When dealing with behaviours that are not accepted at Highvale Primary School, all staff are:

**Calm      Considerate      Brief      Immediate      Respectful**

This is designed to promote and maintain a positive, safe and supportive learning environment for all students and staff.

#### Minor Behaviours

Not following instructions  
Disrespectful property use  
Inappropriate language (name calling)  
Unsafe behaviour  
Rudeness/ Disrespect  
Disruption (low level)

#### Major Behaviours

Leaving designated area without permission  
Property damage / Theft  
Repeated, purposeful minor behaviours  
Inappropriate language (racist, sexist, homophobic, transphobic, swearing or sexual, when directed at someone)  
Defiance  
Disruption (repeated & purposeful)  
Bullying  
Inappropriate touching  
Breaching privacy (e.g. in the toilets & online)
