Expected behaviours are explicitly taught and highlighted through three core values, which are:



Expected behaviours are rewarded with hole punches in the associated card. When the student has filled their punch card with hole punches, they bring it to the office to place a star in the whole-school rewards jar.

If a child doesn't know how to write **we teach**

If a child doesn't know how to swim **we teach**

If a child doesn't know how to behave **we TEACH!**

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HOW WE DEAL WITH UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

When dealing with behaviours that are not accepted at Highvale Primary School, all staff are:

Calm Considerate Brief Immediate Respectful

Breaching privacy (e.g. in the toilets & online)
