

LOCAL EXCURSION CONSENT FORM 2022

In 2022 Greater Shepparton Secondary College may take students outside of school grounds to undertake educational activities in the local area.

The purpose of this form is to obtain parent/carer consent for local excursions during 2022.

This form does NOT provide consent for excursions that go beyond the local area.

Local Excursions

Local excursions are excursions to locations within walking distance of the school and do not involve 'Adventure Activities' and/or a cost to families.

Local excursions that your child may participate in throughout 2022 could include:

- Physical Education lessons at local sports facilities eg. Shepparton Stadium, Major League Indoor Sports, Kialla Bowls Club, Mooroopna Golf Club
- Careers and Pathways programs at Latrobe University and/or GOTAFE Shepparton
- BEACON Work Readiness program at Kidstown
- Lighthouse Industry Immersions at local businesses
- Whole school sports activities Athletics day, cross country and interschool sports.

Notification of Local Excursions

Greater Shepparton Secondary College will NOT seek further consent from you before local excursions take place. However, we will provide advanced notice to parents/carers of upcoming local excursions through one or all of the following: the school newsletter, class notes, personal phone message or through use of Compass text message or email.

For local excursions that occur on a recurring basis, Greater Shepparton Secondary College will notify parents/carers once only, prior to the commencement of the recurring event, eg; weekly sports lessons at the local sports facilities.

Please keep the school informed of any updated contact details to ensure you receive these notifications.

First Aid and Medical Attention

Where necessary, school staff will administer first aid. School staff will also seek emergency medical attention for your child if it is considered reasonably necessary. Any costs associated with student injury rest with parents/carers unless the Department of Education and Training is liable in negligence (liability is not automatic).

Accident and Ambulance Cover

The Department of Education and Training does not provide student accident insurance or ambulance cover. Parents may wish to obtain this cover, depending on their health insurance arrangements and any other personal considerations.
