1. Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Services

HOLYOAKE

- o AOD Counselling for individuals and significant others
- Holyoake offers counselling and support to people who may be experiencing problems with their own or someone else's substance use. Individual counselling and group counselling is available along with specially designed programs to assist individuals and their families to cope with the consequences of AOD use. Our team provides specialised counselling and support for:
 - Individuals
 - Significant others
 - Families
 - Youth
- Holyoake also provides Afterhours support for individuals that are unable to attend the office during business hours. This includes evenings and weekends by appointment only.
- Integrated Support Team
- Holyoake's Integrated Support Team offers a holistic approach to caring for individuals impacted by the harms of AOD use. The team consists of a Clinical Case Manager, Peer Support Workers, and a Doctor, who provide wrap around support in the form of medical assessments, pharmacotherapy, case management, counselling, mentoring, advocacy and group therapy programs.
- o AOD Court Diversion Programs
- Specialised Court Diversion Officers attend court in Northam, Narrogin, Merredin and Moora. They support people who are eligible and who wish to participate in a pre-sentence AOD support program. These programs are available for adults and youth.



WCADS Prevention Team

- Holyoake's Wheatbelt Prevention Team offers prevention activity/initiatives to individuals, service providers, workplaces and communities in relation to mental health and wellbeing, suicide prevention and alcohol and other drug harm minimisation. Preventative activities include Community Wellbeing Plans, Suicide Prevention Community Action Plans, Alcohol and Other Drug Management Plans, education, training and workshops for professionals, paraprofessionals, volunteers and community members, community awareness campaigns, workplace wellbeing and professional self-care presentations and resources, postvention support and the production of the Yirra Koorl Newsletter.

 - Aftercare Coordinator program (ACC)
 - Holyoake's Wheatbelt Suicide Support Aftercare Coordinator program (ACC) offers support to individuals in the Wheatbelt of all ages who have recently attempted suicide or are experiencing suicidal thoughts. Intensive ongoing case management support, skill development, and suicide risk assessment and monitoring are offered at no cost. Through case management support, the Aftercare Coordinator can link an individual and significant other(s) (parents/carers/siblings/daughter/son) with other agencies to provide additional support as needed. GPs and hospital staff are encouraged to refer to Holyoake's ACC program for individuals who are considered low to moderate risk of suicide, where their suicidality has been triggered by a life stressor. If an individual is considered high risk, the person should be referred to the Wheatbelt Mental Health Service.
