Program Overview

To complete the RII20120 Certificate II in Resources and Infrastructure Work Preparation, students will undertake 11 key training units.

The course is delivered through a mix of hands-on, face-to-face learning at our modern, purpose-built training facility, along with some online research and assessments to complete outside the classroom.

Designed in consultation with industry, this course helps students build the core skills and confidence needed to take their first steps into the mining and construction sectors. It focuses on developing practical knowledge and the ability to carry out everyday tasks safely and effectively.

Program Delivery

Duration: Approximately 20 weeks over 2 terms (up to 6 months total completion).

Schedule: 1 day per week of face-to-face training at our purpose-built facility.

Additional Requirements: Online learning and assessments outside face-to-face sessions.

This course is designed to be self-paced, with learners attending structured, in-person training one day per week. To meet the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) requirements and ensure a solid understanding of the foundational knowledge, students will also be expected to complete additional learning and assessments in their own time.

The total completion time may vary depending on individual progress and circumstances.
