

MOBILE PHONES – STUDENT USE

PURPOSE

To explain to our school community the Department's and Wales Street Primary School's policy requirements and expectations relating to students using mobile phones and other personal mobile devices including smart watches during school hours.

SCOPE

This policy applies to:

- 1. All students at Wales Street Primary School and,
- 2. Students' personal mobile phones and other personal wearable devices brought onto school premises during school hours, including recess and lunchtime.

DEFINITIONS

A mobile phone is a telephone with access to a cellular (telecommunication) system, with or without a physical connection to a network. "For the purpose of this policy, "mobile phone" refers to mobile phones and any device that may connect to or have a similar functionality to a mobile phone such as smart watches."

POLICY

Wales Street Primary School understands that students may bring a personal mobile phone to school, particularly if they are travelling independently to and from school.

At Wales Street Primary School:

- Students who choose to bring mobile phones to school must have them switched off and securely stored in the school office during school hours
- Exceptions to this policy may be applied if certain conditions are met (see below for further information)
- When emergencies occur, parents or carers should reach their child by calling the school's office.

Personal mobile phone use

In accordance with the Department's <u>Mobile Phones — Student Use Policy</u> issued by the Minister for Education, personal mobile phones must not be used at Wales Street Primary School during school hours, including lunchtime and recess, unless an exception has been granted.

Where a student has been granted an exception, the student must use their mobile phone for the purpose for which the exception was granted, and in a safe, ethical and responsible manner.

Secure storage

Mobile phones owned by students at Wales Street Primary School are considered valuable items and are brought to school at the owner's (student's or parent/carer's) risk. Students are encouraged not to bring a mobile phone to school unless there is a compelling reason to do so. Please note that Wales Street Primary School does not have accident insurance for accidental property damage or theft. Students and their parents/carers are encouraged to obtain appropriate insurance for valuable items.

Where students bring a mobile phone to school, Wales Street Primary School will provide secure storage. Secure storage is storage that cannot be readily accessed by those without permission to do so. At Wales Street Primary School students are required to hand their mobile phone or wearable device into the school administration office to be placed in a lockable cupboard.

Enforcement

Students who fail to hand in their mobile device or use their personal mobile device at Wales Street Primary School may be issued with consequences consistent with our school's existing Student Wellbeing and Engagement policy, Code of Conduct or Bullying Policies.

At Wales Street Primary School inappropriate use of mobile phones is **any use during school hours or before or after school while on school grounds**, unless an exception has been granted, and particularly use of a mobile phone:

- in any way that disrupts the learning of others
- to send inappropriate, harassing or threatening messages or phone calls
- to engage in inappropriate social media use including cyber bullying
- to capture video or images of people, including students, teachers and members of the school community without their permission
- to capture video or images in the school toilets
