Children that turn 4 from May 1 - October 31 start at the mid-year intake (beginning of term 3). Children that turn 4 after October 31 start Preschool the following year.

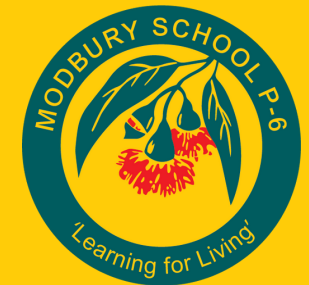
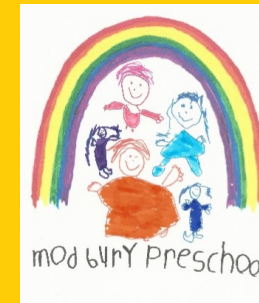

What makes our school based preschool unique?

- Children from 3-6 years of age can discover and explore learning.
- Transition for this age group is seamless and supports the Same Start First Day policy.
- A Nature Play learning environment.
- Children explore the topics they love and use their interests to create new learning experiences. Children build relationships with each other and with the wider school community.
- Children engage in a play-based learning approach, which acknowledges the whole child in the Early Years which leads to better academic outcomes in both Literacy and Numeracy.
- The learning environment is carefully designed reflective of the latest Early Childhood research.

Operating Hours

Modbury Preschool operates between 9am and 3pm on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday every ODD week of the term and Monday and Tuesday every EVEN week.

- 10.30am: Literacy Groups, Healthy Snack.
- 11.00am: Indoor/Outdoor Learning through play.
- 12noon: Numeracy Groups, Lunch & Relaxation.
- 12.45pm: Indoor/Outdoor Learning through play.
- 2.30pm: Pack up, Pack bags.
- 2.50pm: Group Time: Music, movement, reflections on learning.
- 3.00pm: Farewell children and families.

In a happy, secure preschool environment, children have opportunities to:

- Be independent
- Develop positive self esteem
- Communicate with other children and adults

- Work alone and in a group
