On the first Open Streets day, 74.7% of students used some form of active transport to get to school (e.g. walk, bike, scoot, or skating). This is a 24.7% increase in active travel when compared to a normal school day in 2022.

Rode more

62.5%

of families said that they rode more (including scoot/skate) on Open Streets days.



Walked more

34%

of families said that they walked more on Open Streets days.



Felt safe to walk or ride Culloden St

95%

of survey respondents felt that Culloden St and Shetland Ave were safe to walk or ride along on trial days, compared to only 26% on normal school days.
