



## **Kyneton Primary School instrumental music program**

### **Instrumental music lessons Grade 2-6**

This is a wonderful opportunity to develop your child's confidence, music-making skills, appreciation and expression, as well as opportunities for diverse community involvement. Collaborative skills and friendships are developed through working closely with others.

Your child will have the opportunity to learn the **flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone, keyboard, guitar, violin, ukulele and voice** with experienced instrumental music teachers. Students in grade 2 are encouraged to learn keyboard/guitar/ ukulele and voice and if they are interested in woodwind/brass or violin please speak to Ms Polly first.

Students are expected to:

- Work respectfully and cooperatively with teachers and other students
- Demonstrate care and respect in the handling and maintenance of their instrument
- Attend weekly lessons and rehearsals, in addition to practising at home
- Contribute actively to school and public performances

### **Lesson structure and timetable**

Students will participate in lessons of single or two to five people during school time and may also participate in school band or ensemble rehearsals at lunchtime.

Lessons will be for 30 minutes and take place during school hours at school. Each small group lesson is carefully constructed to ensure students are generally at the same level of development. Students are required to commit to a term.

**Regular home practice is essential.** The amount of practice will vary and will be advised by the instrumental teacher.

### **Fees**

Lessons range from \$25-\$35 per session. The instrumental teacher will invoice you.

Most terms will consist of 8-10 lessons and the full-term fees must be paid before instrumental lessons commence. Instrumental teachers will invoice families directly.

### **Missed lessons and Cancellation Policy**

- If your child is unable to attend a scheduled lesson, please notify the instrumental teacher by 9am on the lesson day to avoid a cancellation fee. If you have notified the teacher by 9am, the instrumental teacher will arrange a catch-up lesson at their earliest convenience and notify you.
- Cessation of instrumental music lessons requires three weeks' notice.

### **Instrument Hire**

- The school has instruments for hire: Flute/Clarinet/Trumpet/Trombone/Violin. (Guitar and ukulele need to be supplied by the students). Students use the school keyboards at school.
- There will be an initial deposit of \$100 for the hire and then \$40 per term.
- This payment is to be made to the office on return of the agreement forms.
- Hire fees must be paid by the start of each term.
