**Campuses:** Clayton, Peninsula, Caulfield, Parkville.

### Monash Guarantee

You may receive a guaranteed place in your desired course with a lower ATAR set by the University if you're eligible for the Monash Guarantee under the categories of:

- Disadvantaged financial background.
- Live in a low socio-economic area.
- Indigenous Australian.
- Attend a Monash list under-represented school.

#### Offers

To receive a guaranteed offer you will need to achieve the minimum ATAR set by the University, meet eligibility criteria for your course, and place the course as your highest preference on VTAC.

You may receive a guaranteed place in your desired course with a lower ATAR set by the University if you're eligible for Access Melbourne under the categories of:

- Disadvantaged financial background.
- Live in a rural or isolated area.
- Indigenous Australian.

To receive a guaranteed offer you will need to achieve the minimum ATAR set by the University, meet eligibility criteria for your course, and place the course as your highest preference on VTAC.

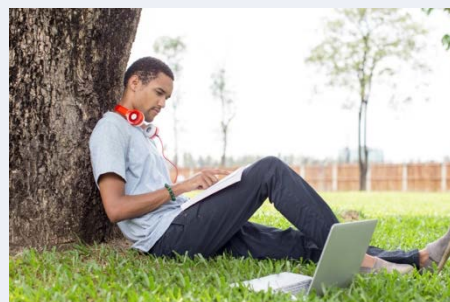

Step 4: offers will be released by VTAC in December and/or January.

**Campuses:** Melbourne and Ballarat.

### ACU Guarantee

ACU Guarantee takes into consideration the following:

- Year 11 academic results
- An optional personal statement

You will need to complete Year 12 exams and meet the prerequisites for your course/s.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1: Search for courses and narrow down your options, [www.acu.edu.au](http://www.acu.edu.au)

Step 2: Complete the ACU Guarantee application by 24 September.

Step 3: Apply for the course/s via VTAC between 2 August - 30 September and list them as your highest preferences.

Step 4: Conditional offers will be made by ACU periodically until October and official offers will be released by VTAC in December and/or January.

## Swinburne University

**Campus:** Hawthorn

### Swinburne Early Entry Program

Swinburne Early Entry Program takes into account:

- a recommendation from your school
- your application

Offers will be 'ATAR free'. You will need to complete Year 12 and meet the prerequisites for your course/s.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1: check that your course is eligible for the program and that you meet the subject prerequisites.

Step 2: organise a recommendation from your school for the program.

Step 3: complete the Early Entry application form direct to Swinburne.

Step 4: submit your application and organise for your school to complete their section of the form. Applications close 31 August.

Step 5: Apply for the course/s via VTAC between 2 August - 30 September and list them as your highest preferences.

Step 6: conditional offers will be released in September from Swinburne and official offers will be released by VTAC in December and/or January.

## Charles Sturt University

**Campus:** Albury-Wodonga

### Charles Sturt Advantage

Charles Sturt Advantage takes into consideration the following:

- Year 11 academic results
- A statement on your 'soft skills'.

You may receive a guaranteed offer by late September. You will need to complete Year 12 and meet the prerequisites for your course/s.

Note – Round 1 applications have closed. Physiotherapy will not be making offers for Round 2.

## Victoria University

**Campuses:** 10 campuses across Victoria.

### VU Guaranteed

The VU Guaranteed program offers Year 12 students from partner schools a guaranteed place at Victoria University (VU) or Victoria University Polytechnic (VU Polytechnic), prior to their final exams.

#### Benefits include:

Eligible applicants will receive an additional 5 ATAR points towards their final selection rank for courses that require an ATAR.

- Access to exclusive VU Guaranteed events
- Tailored course advice on your study options.
- You may receive a scholarship.

Step 4: Offers will be made by VU periodically and official offers will be released by VTAC in December and/or January.

## RMIT University

**Campuses:** City, Bundoora, Brunswick.

### Schools Network Access Program (SNAP)

The SNAP scheme is for selected schools.

#### How it works

Eligible students can gain entry into a Bachelor degree with a lower English Study Score and with a lower ATAR.

## Federation University

**Campuses:** 6 campuses across Ballarat, Gippsland, Berwick, and Wimmera.

### Early Offer Program

To be eligible for an early offer you must:

- Be a current Australian year 12 student or a recent Australian year 12 graduate who has not undertaken further study.
- Meet the pre-requisites for the program.
- Apply by 3 December 2021.
- Apply via VTAC and list the Federation University degree in your preference list.
