Have a good heart

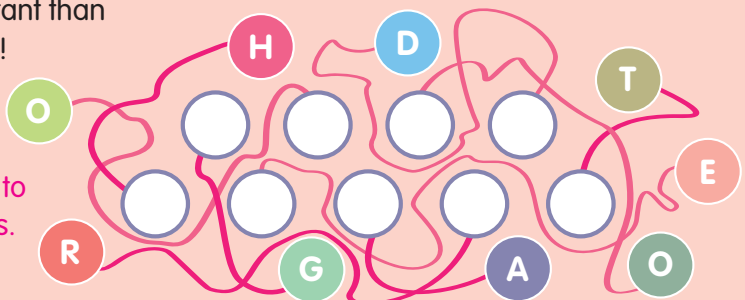
Circle the pictures of the children who have good hearts and are being kind.
