OHS, Maintenance & Improvements

- School Hall Over the school holiday period, the school hall restumping on the eastern side of the hall was completed. The restumping addressed a number of issues including some cracks in the storeroom and realigning of the door frame. The window was able to be replaced and the entry became functional again. The next step is to replace the current kitchen in the hall and then replace the flooring with the aim for this to be completed by the end of 2024.
