

COLLEGE UNIFORM CHANGES

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As shared in Woodchatta, Ranier Uniforms remain our official supplier and are supporting a refresh of the College uniform. The aim is to ensure consistency across all year levels while improving quality and updating our look. The following information provides all families with the key changes especially relating to the College PE uniform.

Key Changes



College Uniform - Same design, higher-quality materials, and standardised colours.

New College Polo - A blue College polo will be compulsory from 2026 (except Year 12, 2026). It will be worn for excursions, immersion programs, certain College functions, and when full uniform is not possible. Available for purchase from Term 3, 2025.

PE Uniform – New designs to strengthen identity and unity. Students will transition fully by the start of 2027. Below are the items that make up the PE Uniform.



Transition Timeline

There will be a phased transition to the new uniforms.

- From the start of 2026: All students (except Year 12) must purchase the new College polo.
- From the start of 2027: All students must wear the updated PE uniform.

This transition period allows families time to adjust and ensures all students are aligned with the new uniform standards.

New College Polo

The new College Polo will be worn when students:

- ✓ attend excursions (that are not House related)
- ✓ are unable to wear the full College uniform)
- ✓ attend immersion or tours (as an addition to their Immersion or Tour polo)
- ✓ representing the College at different functions as specified by the College





The House shirt

The House shirt is to be worn when:

- ✓ attending PE at the Oxford Falls campus
- ✓ participating in PE at the Chatswood campus
- ✓ attending College Swimming and Athletics carnival
- ✓ participating in College House events
- Junior School will be able to wear their House shirt to school when they are participating in PE at either the Chatswood or Oxford Falls campus.



Training tops - Guidelines 2025

Training tops can be worn:

• to and from SPX Cocurricular Training

Training tops should be worn:

- for SPX Cocurricular training sessions
- to and from SPX Cocurricular fixtures (acceptable as a mode of dress when attending Saturday fixtures)
- as a match day warm up top and for reserve bench duties



- Training tops **must not** be worn to school on regular school days for PDHPE.
- They are for training sessions and match days only.
- Training tops are not to be worn as part of Chatswood campus PDHPE practical classes.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION (FAQ)

The following FAQ may assist you in understanding the changes that are taking place with our uniform.

1. What PE uniform should my son wear when attending the Oxford Falls campus?

- a. When travelling to and from the Oxford Falls, students should wear the College PE uniform
 - College House Polo
 - College Navy Sports Shorts
 - College White Socks
 - Training shoes/appropriate footwear
 - College Tracksuit (optional)
 - Rain jacket (wet weather option)

b. While **participating** in the Oxford Falls PE Program, students may wear:

- Any College crested sports uniform (eg: rugby or football jersey, etc ...)
- College training top
- College rain jacket
- College Tracksuit top
- College Track Pants

2. What PE uniform can I wear when participating in PE classes at the Chatswood campus?

Students are only permitted to wear their College PE uniform during PE classes. That is:

- College House Polo
- College Navy Sports Shorts
- College White Socks
- Training shoes/appropriate footwear
- College Tracksuit (optional)
- Rain jacket (wet weather option)

3. Will the older sports uniform attire be acceptable to wear?

Use of the 'older' sports uniform will be phased out by the end of 2026. All students must have the updated PE uniform by the beginning of the 2027 school year.







4. What uniform do I wear if I am unable to wear my full College uniform?

Students who cannot wear their full College uniform, for whatever reason, should wear:

- New College Polo
- College Navy sport shorts
- College White Socks
- appropriate training shoes
- College Tracksuit (optional)

5. When can students wear the rain jacket?

As stated in the diary, rain jackets:

- can be worn as part of the College tracksuit when required.
- can be worn in the event of wet weather over full summer or winter uniform.
- must **not** be worn instead of the winter blazer or jumper

Please note: The current College Rain Jacket will not available once the current stock has been exhausted. The College is currently investigating alternatives. College umbrellas are available for purchase through the uniform shop.

6. For Saturday games

- Students must wear appropriate College Sports uniform (Basketball, Cricket, Rugby, Football etc.).
- The full College tracksuit is an (optional) extra. Otherwise, either Full Summer or Full Winter School uniform should be worn specific to the season.
- In the case of cold weather, College scarves can be worn. These can be purchased through canteen at Oxford Falls.
- Students are encouraged to wear their sport specific College training tops to games in instances where Full School uniform is not required.
- **NO MUFTI** is permitted. Students **must** attend all College fixtures and events in College uniform unless stated otherwise.

The 2026 College diary will be updated to include the PE uniform requirements as outlined in this correspondence. We encourage you to discuss these upcoming changes with your son(s) to ensure they are well-prepared.

College Leaders will also be outlining these updates in upcoming year group meetings to support a smooth transition.

Thank you for your ongoing support. We look forward to seeing our students continue to wear their uniform with pride.
