UTS - Entry to Science - Pathway through aptitude assessment Registration closes midnight 8 January 2023

The aptitude assessment is an opportunity for students to demonstrate their potential, and possibly secure an offer to study at UTS Science. The assessment is designed to assess your analytical and critical thinking skills. It is a general knowledge-based assessment and there is no need to study for it Monday 16 January 2023 or Tuesday 17 January 2023, 10:00 am (and 1:30 pm subject to registration numbers). Please be available for both sessions. Who can take the test: Future students of UTS Science who want to commence study in Autumn 2022 (commences on 20 February 2023), but feel their HSC results might not reflect their scientific potential. Those students who have not completed the assessment in the last 12 months. Future students should have a current application lodged with the Universities Admission Centre (UAC) and chose the UTS Science's course as their first preference.

UTS - Support your UAC application with the Engineering and IT Questionnaire

If you fall short of the selection rank requirement by one to three points, we'll still consider your application if you submit the Engineering and IT Questionnaire and demonstrate a strong motivation to study engineering or IT. You achieved a minimum selection rank of 75. This selection rank cut-off includes your raw ATAR and adjustment factors. You've listed UTS Engineering or IT as your first preference in UAC. Download this template and input your responses to these three questions where asked:

Why are you interested in studying at UTS and what do you expect to gain from your experience in the Faculty of Engineering and IT? Which of your personal attributes and skills will assist you most in your future career? Describe something you have created or designed and how it is related to your preferred course.

ACU Early Entry Guarantee Applications Closing Soon 23 September 2022

Guarantee your place at ACU, even before your Year 12 exams. The ACU Guarantee program offers eligible Year 12 students a place at ACU based on your Year 11 results. Offers may be made as early as July. While successful applicants must still complete their Year 12 exams, you can do so secure in the knowledge that your marks from Year 11 meet our entry requirements. You may also enhance your entry score by including a short personal statement that gives ACU an insight into your personal circumstances and motivation for university study.
