

NOTICE OF CLOSURE

Dear Resident/Business Owner

PROPOSED THOROUGHFARE CLOSURE – HAMILTON STREET, SEVENOAKS STREET AND RAILWAY PARADE, QUEENS PARK.

We would like to inform you about the proposed temporary thoroughfare closures in your area as part of the METRONET Victoria Park-Canning Level Crossing Removal Project. These proposed closures are essential for the relocation of waterpipes and to rebuild the Hamilton Street intersections, at Sevenoaks Street and Railway Parade. These works are scheduled to take place from Monday, 8 July 2024 to December 2024.

To undertake the works, road modifications are required including reducing Sevenoaks Street (near the Hamilton Street intersection) to single lane in each direction. There will be restrictions to turning movements to/from Hamilton Street for the duration of the works. Traffic management is proposed in stages to minimise impacts and to maintain vehicle access along Sevenoaks Street at all times.

The proposed closures will impact road and shared path users on Railway Parade (between Mills Street north and Dora Street), Sevenoaks Street (between Mills Street south and Stockman Way) and Hamilton Street (between Walton Street and Richards Place) in Queens Park. Access for local residents will be maintained, however will be via alternate routes (see maps overleaf).

A reduction in speed and temporary lane closures are necessary to safely undertake these works. Road conditions may be unfamiliar, so motorists are asked to exercise caution, allow extra travel time and follow traffic management signage in place.

Plans detailing the area affected by the closure are overleaf and may also be viewed in the City of Canning offices and on the City of Canning and METRONET project websites.

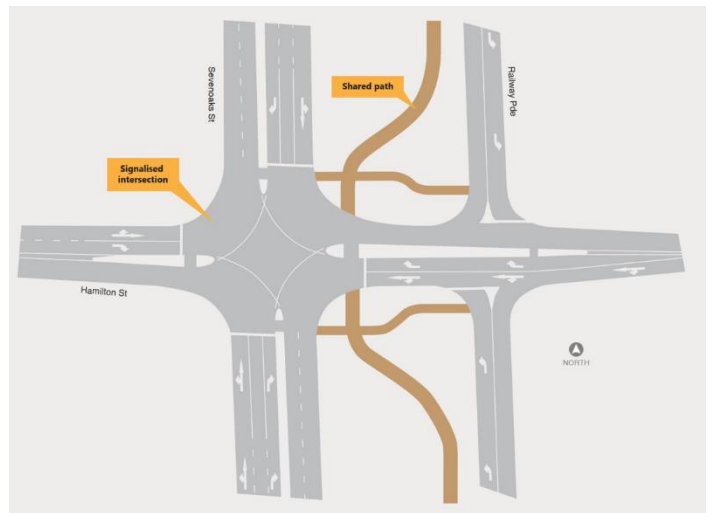
Stage 2 – mid-August to mid-September 2024
