## MULTIPLE OPPORTUNITIES FOR OPEN ROLES IN HOSPITALS: FOOD SERVICES, LAUNDRY, PORTERAGE & ADMINISTRATION

### Units of Competency:

- ✓ CHCCOM005 – Communicate & work in health or community services
- ✓ BSBCRT311 – Apply critical thinking skills in a team environment
- ✓ SIRXCOM002 – Work effectively in a team
- ✓ BSBPEF301 – Organise personal work priorities

### Eligibility Criteria:

Community Work Skills assists disadvantaged Queensland job seekers to gain nationally recognised skills and qualifications up to a Certificate III level.

To be eligible you are a Queensland resident who is either:

- ineligible for Australian Government employment services or assistance, or
- have accessed Australian Government services for more than six months and remain unemployed

### You must also be:

\*15 years or older and no longer enrolled in school

- ready to commence work at completion of the qualification
- an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen.

This training is proudly funded and supported by the Qld Government through its Skilling Queenslanders for Work initiative.

**Non-accredited training will include:**

- Goal setting
- Resume development
- Job applications
- Interview techniques

**MENTORING & EXTRA SUPPORT** with transport to training and work.

Each participant provided with ETC polo shirt, black pants and work shoes.

### Participants must be immunised with hospital required vaccinations as follows:

- Measles Mumps Rubella x 2
- Pertussis (Whooping Cough) vaccine
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine
- HEP-B x 2
- COVID Vaccines x 2

ETC will assist with payment for vaccinations required for working within a hospital. Students will be provided with 2 weeks of work experience with the employer as an optional addition to this training, preparing students for transition to employment.
